## **Message from the Pastor**

Next week I'll be going on my annual retreat, from Sunday after Masses till Friday. This year I am going to Colorado Springs to the novitiate of the Holy Cross Fathers. My cousin's son is a novice this year and I've never been to Colorado aside from a layover in Denver, so I thought that would be a good place for a retreat. Can't wait to see the Rockies up close. It's been on my bucket list for a while. I think it will be a great setting for time alone with God. I'll be praying for you throughout my days in Colorado.

When I get back we will be celebrating the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ (in Latin, Corpus Christi). After the 11 am Mass on Sunday, June 3rd, we will process around the block with our Lord in the Monstrance and have benediction outside the Spring Street entrance. I encourage all who are present at the 11 am Mass to stick around and join the procession in which we proclaim our faith in the Eucharistic Presence loud and clear for all to see, as we parade in the street.

Belief in the Real Presence is not to be kept hidden, like its our little secret. No, our community is in desperate need of the Real Presence of Christ. We need to shout it from the roof top and boldly proceed through the streets, even if it is only around our block. If you think about it, the Eucharist deserves a full-blown parade through downtown St. Marys, with the band playing and the fire trucks and police cars joining in. The Eucharistic Presence of Jesus is the most astounding thing we have ever seen in this world, next to the Incarnate Christ who walked the earth 2,000 years ago. But it's the same Jesus Christ! He lives among us! He is here!

So, please, show your faith in the Real Presence. Stay around after the 11 am Mass for the procession. And if you usually attend an earlier Mass, come back at 11:45 for the procession. Let's show St. Marys where the Lord dwells. In St. Marys, Christ the Lord dwells, really and fully present, at Holy Rosary Church. Don't shortchange our Blessed Lord. Join in on the Corpus Christi procession on June 3rd after the 11 am Mass.




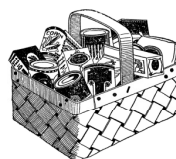
## NOVELTY BOOTH NEWS

## AGAPE SUMMER BREAKFAST/LUNCH PROGRAM

Agape will be offering their Summer Feeding Program bags again this year. It is hard to believe that this will be our twelfth year. Since we provide these bags to all the students who were enrolled in their respective schools free and reduced breakfast and/or lunch programs, we potentially could offer these bags to 1057 students each month. While this is a staggering number of students who are enrolled, we provide for an average of 910 to 965 bags each month.

Each student will receive a total of 41 shelf stable items, 6 cold and frozen items and 5 soft and squishy items. These are packed into a total of 3 bags. The shelf stable items can be pre-packed but the cold and frozen and the soft and squishy must to be packed as needed.

This requires a substantial amount of work. This is why we require volunteer groups to assist in these packing parties. If you have adults and children that have time during the day, evenings or Saturdays, please let us know so we can make arrangements to have them pack bags for us. Only an hour or so is needed and we can accommodate anywhere from 5 to 35 or so at a time.
