Message from the Pastor

I really enjoyed my retreat a couple of weeks ago. Colorado was so beautiful. I got away from it all, turning off my phone for a week and really trying to connect with God. Each year I go on retreat and I can't thank God enough for giving me the opportunity to spend some quality time with Him.

Retreats can be difficult. Can you imagine me not talking or seeing people for a whole week? I get antsy. I can't sit for extended periods of time. I get distracted. (Did I describe most of you as well?) But, I try, knowing that it is good for my soul. A retreat can do so much good for your mind, your heart and your will; as well as for your body...I rested a lot during the week.

I think I asked you this before, but I'll ask it again – Have you been on a spiritual retreat lately? Probably not. And I understand. You only get so many days off work. You have to take your family on vacation to the beach or to Disneyworld. You have a lot to do around the house. There are many reasons not to go on retreat. I wonder if we realize the necessity of a yearly retreat for our spiritual lives. We need to get away by ourselves and spend time alone with God. We need it.

How many problems and difficulties are you dealing with in your daily life? How many relationships are you struggling in? How has your Catholic life been going? Have you been indifferent towards God and the Church? Have you been a little lax in your prayer life? Have you gotten a little distant from God? If yes is the answer to any of these questions, then you need a retreat.

There are many retreat houses available, even right in our area at Maria Stein. Just a couple of days out there would be so good for you. Of course, a directed retreat is usually better, where you receive spiritual talks and Mass and Confession from a good priest with others. Google "Catholic retreats near me" and see what you find. Check out the Spiritual Center of Maria Stein for what they have on their program.

Maybe you could combine a retreat with a vacation. Just spend a few days on retreat and then visit some sites near the retreat house. There are some scenic spots around the country that have retreat houses near. Be creative and you will have a great experience. It's a matter of wanting to grow closer to God. If you do, then you will go on a retreat. My hope and my prayer is that you do.

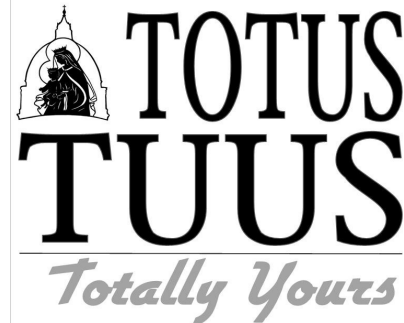
Totus Tuus Summer Camp

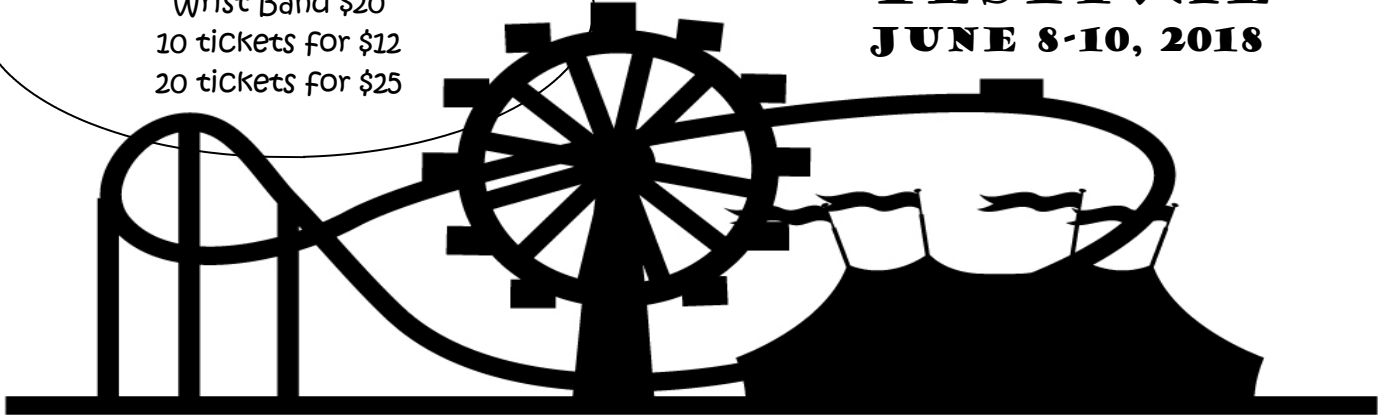
