Message from the Pastor

As a priest and pastor who gives a message from the pulpit each week to close to 1,200 church goers, as well as a homily for the daily church service, I have always said that I would never preach what I don't at least try to practice. Well, one morning recently, following a reading from the Prophet Jeremiah, chapter 15, I spoke about how we many times lament all the "continuous pains" and "incurable wounds" we are afflicted with every day, as Jeremiah put it. He cried out in anguish of heart, "Woe to me!" Life is hard and sometimes we just can't find a way to get by in one piece. What does the Lord God answer the prophet? "I am with you to deliver you and rescue you." So often we simply forget that God is with us. He is by our side. He holds us in the palm of His Hand. He wants to be there for us, to see us through the dark times when life gets to be too much for us. But he seems to be hard to find sometimes. Where are you Lord?! You are awfully silent. Why are you hiding?

Then later in my homily that day I said that we have to find that treasure of God's presence right in front of us; that pearl of great value, as the Gospel reading of that day from Matthew, chapter 13, tells us. God is here! All around us; as plain as day (for those with the faith to see Him). We see God in a baby's smile; in a friend's embrace, in a cool breeze on a hot day, in the sunset on a summer's evening. I told the people to try and see God in the things around them that day, maybe in the sunset that evening.

So, later that same day I did my exercises and after I thought it was such a nice evening that I would go out by the grotto near the statue of Our Lady of Lourdes and pray with St. Bernadette, the young girl who saw the Blessed Mother at Lourdes, in France, some 160 years ago. I wasn't thinking so much about what I had said earlier in church. Just then as I sat on the bench near the grotto, the sun eased down in the western sky and in that pleasant, peaceful, quiet moment on the first day of August, I saw Him. He was with me. He was right there watching over me like that dying sun in its last shining gasp as the day ended. A tremendous calm overtook me. To realize you are in the presence of the One, True God, who made you, gave you being, and holds you in existence, is the greatest thing you can feel. You just have to take a moment and with faith see Him. God is with us. Thank you, Lord.
