Message from the Pastor

I'm heading back to Italy on a trip I've organized. I'm leading a group from our area (and a few from outside our area) to be on pilgrimage to many holy sites in Italy including Monte Cassino (St. Benedict's monastery), Sorrento and Capri Island (the most beautiful place in all the world), San Giovanni Rotondo (of St. Padre Pio fame), Lanciano (which has a Eucharistic miracle), Bagnoregio (a breath-taking village on a cliff where St. Bonaventure was born), and of course Rome, the heart of the Catholic Church, where pilgrims have gone for centuries to visit the Tomb of the Apostle and first Pope, St. Peter, and to see the Holy Father.

I love Italy. It is such a warm and inviting place, full of history and mystery, good food and wine, lovely country sides, and churches everywhere. There is nothing like real Italian cuisine, pasta and pizza, and everything in between. The coffee...oh the coffee. It is so good! And the bread! I can't wait! There is nothing else like it.

I have had the good fortune to be able to study in Rome for four years when I was a religious brother and seminarian in the 1990's. Since the year 2000, I have been back to Italy a total of ten times. This will be my eleventh trip. Some people go to Florida, or the Outer Banks, California or Hawaii. I go to Italy. These trips have been some of the best times of my life. Like the time my sister experienced a healing of her knees at the tomb of St. Francis of Assisi which allowed her to enjoy the rest of the trip with little pain. Or the time I just happened to be in a taxi cab with my other sisters going to dinner for my birthday while in Rome and running into one of my group who went out jogging and got lost. That was a miracle. He would have been lost all night. Or the time one person in our group got the chance to shake hands with Pope Francis and speak to him, one of thirty people out of many thousands in attendance to do so.

Those were some great memories. And, of course, the groups I've taken on pilgrimage were the best. We had so many laughs and good times over there (and a little wine to go with them). So, I am just overjoyed to be able to lead another group to the Eternal City and to other great and meaningful religious sites in Italy.

I will keep you all in my prayers throughout my trip. Say a prayer for safe travel for us. Thanks and Arrivederci!
