MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

My dear parishioners,

We are in a time of crisis in our world and in our Church. We are being faced with a great challenge. We must stop the spread of this virus. To help do this, our archbishop has decided to prohibit the gathering of the faithful for public celebrations of the sacraments. All Catholics therefore are dispensed from the obligation of attending Sunday Mass through Easter.

I will be celebrating daily Mass at the usual times in my rectory. Be with me in spirit.

We will be live streaming on Facebook the Sunday 11am Mass starting Sunday, March 22nd. You can also pick up the daily Mass at coldwatercluster.org under the Holy Trinity tab. There are several other sources for a live Mass available such as the Cathedral Mass on Facebook under the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. Unfortunately, we cannot offer Holy Communion to you during this time. I can only give Holy Communion to those who are seriously ill or dying.

So, we need to embrace our faith in the domestic church, drawing the family close through prayer and devotions. I would suggest watching the Mass online or at least hearing the readings for the Mass and praying in union with the Mass being celebrated privately by me. You can find the readings for Mass at uscgb.org. Also, check out ewtn.com for many Catholic prayers and devotions.

Our bulletin will be online, as well as available in print at the church doors. If you visit the church or adoration chapel for private prayer or the sacrament of Confession, please use the door near the office. Call the office at 419-394-5050 if you do not know the code (or after hours at 419-733-7982). Use hand sanitizer before and after you are there and a sanitizing wipe for the pew or kneeler you touched. Keep safe distance between yourselves and no more than 10 persons will be allowed in the chapel at one time.

We can get through this time of testing if we truly have faith. Keep praying for the health and welfare of our country and our church.
