Message from the Pastor

This Sunday, June 7th, we are honoring our eighth grade Holy Rosary School graduates at the 11am Mass. These kids were just little first graders in my first year as pastor, 2012-13. I am so proud of them and so happy that I got to be a part of their lives during elementary school. I wish them all the best in high school and beyond. I wish I could be with them for Confirmation and high school graduation, too. I am going to miss them.

Holy Rosary School has been a very special part of my time here in St. Marys. I loved teaching and being with all the kids who came through here over these past eight years. I will miss the kick ball games on the playground and being with them for lunch in the cafeteria, among other things. I will never forget throwing the candy at the All Saints' Day parade and my 50th birthday party. Some priests think having a school attached to the parish is a bother and just more work. I thought it was a source of my spiritual happiness that I could take a small part in the Christian formation of our youth. I'll never forget the many fun and rewarding experiences I had at our school.

Good things have happened at Holy Rosary School since I came here. We went from 117 Pre-K thru 8th Grade students in 2011-12 to 170 for this upcoming school year (as of today, plus 8 children in our special ABLE class). I had as a goal to reach 180 students. The ABLE program for autistic children is something that I am so happy we were able to take on. The ABLE kids have been a special love of our students and the whole program has been a great service to our community.

Part of the reason we increased enrollment was our returning teaching staff. For the last few years, almost all our teachers have continued teaching here. The teachers at Holy Rosary are exceptional, not to mention Lora Krugh, our principal, who has been an outstanding leader of the school and someone I admire. We worked so well together for the good of our students and I will miss her. Our whole parish has done so much for our school. It could not exist without your support and prayers.

So, as I move on to another parish and school, I pray that you will all continue to strive to keep Holy Rosary School going strong. Father Witt will be great asset to the good of the school and, with your help, will keep it going well into the future.

I also desire that the families of St. Patrick's parish will strongly consider sending their children to Holy Rosary School. My dream is that one day they will have to change the name of the school to *Holy Rosary/St. Patrick Catholic School*. There is still room for growth and the program at our school, especially the religious formation and Catholic identity, is a powerful tool to help our young people live out their baptismal commitment and keep their faith. I will continue to pray for the school, and I wish everyone many blessings and continued success.

The table will have a basket for cards if you so desire to provide him one. Please know the parishes are providing Father a gift as a thank you.
2. The **8:00am and 9:30am Masses** may sing "Battle Hymn of the Republic" as Father exits. Due to close Mass times that follow, both Masses will have a basket for Father available for any cards/gifts. Again, please know the parishes are providing Father a gift as a thank you.
3. After the **11am Mass on the 21st**, Father will be stationed outside the church Carport behind a table and will be available to hear your goodbye wishes as you leave church. After Deacon Marty's last words, we will sing "Battle Hymn of the Republic" as Father exits Mass. Ushers will release parishioners one row at a time, following Father's exit. Parishioners who wish to say goodbye can greet Father as they exit. Should you not be able to stay you can exit through the Spring St. exit or the Pine St. exit. The table will have a basket for cards if you so desire to provide him one. Please know the parishes are providing Father a gift as a thank you.

Minutes of the Holy Rosary Pastoral Council – May 26, 2020

Meeting was called to order at 6:30pm by Matt Kinkley and opened with prayer.

Members present: Matt Kinkley, Doug Moran, Charlotte Duncan, Peg Larkin, Al Meinerding, Linda Tebbe, Pam Rammel, Tom Scott and Fr. Barry. Deacon Marty and Nick Kiel were excused.

The minutes of the February 25, 2020, meeting were approved as printed.

Altar Society - Due to COVID19, the March, April & May meetings were cancelled, as well as all the events we normally host in the Spring. We were able to provide pies for a couple of the K of C fish fries before they were suspended. Meetings will resume in the fall beginning September 15th. Current treasury balance is \$11,074.44.

K of C - Ticket campaign is in progress. 100% of sales go to Agape. Chicken dinners will be available May 31st.

Education//Religious Education - RCIA Elect May 30th at 7:00pm. (live streamed). 13 new members entering the Church. 4:30pm Mass will still be held. Holy Rosary 8th grade graduation is June 7th.

1st Communion for the 2nd grade students is June 13th for CCD students at the 4:30pm Mass and June 14th at 11:00am Mass for HRS students. Jesus Retreat and Totus Tuus have been cancelled.

170 students (Pre-K thru 8th) and 8 students in our Autism Unit are enrolled at Holy Rosary School for the 2020-21 school year. The Autism Unit received approval to run a Summer School program for 6 students: 3 weeks in June & 2 weeks in July.

Maintenance - A new camera has been purchased for permanent live-streaming of all Masses. The new camera ties into the new sound system very nicely. Until the new camera is installed the 11:00am Mass will continue be the only Mass live streamed (plus some of the special Masses).

The south entrance to the school has been renovated and Vern Stucke will continue the renovation by replacing the landscaped bricks that surround the play ground on South and Vine Streets with poured concrete to match what he did on the south entrance.

We are waiting for Fr. Witt to get here to continue with projects yet to be determined.

New control system is very sensitive to inside/outside changes in temperature & we are still fine tuning & dealing with these nuances.

Finances - Jess Rammel reported that through this time we are holding our own. Please continue with your weekly offerings. Holy Rosary received a PPP (Payroll Protection Program) loan, we are only 2 of 6 churches in the Archdiocese to get any money during the first disbursement. There is \$17,000 left in Capital Improvement Fund. Capital Campaign will have an update at the end of July. Still need 1-2 people to serve on the Finance Committee. 420 Reverse Raffle tickets have been sold so far. Tickets are still being sold at the parish office M, Tu, Th, Fr from 7:30am - Noon and Wednesday 10am - 2pm.

Liturgy Board - No meeting. Live streaming - going well with just a few glitches Thanks to Tom Largent for setting that up. Because of COVID 19 no hymnals or missalettes are being used.

Old Business – Strategic Planning discussion has been tabled until Fr. Witt has settled in .

New Business – The June 20-21st Masses will be Fr. Barry's last here at Holy Rosary. He will be leaving June 25th. Fr. Witt's 1st Mass here will be Friday, June 26th. Fr. Recker will be saying the weekend Masses on June 27 & 28th.

Funeral Masses have begun, however, there will be no luncheons afterward.

Pastor's Report – Thank you from Fr. Barry to the Council and the Parish for all their support and during these past 8 years.

Meeting was adjourned and closed with prayer.

GUIDELINES FOR RETURNING MASS

Please remember that the faithful have been dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. Thus, those who wish to participate in Mass and receive Holy Communion can do so by attending a Mass any day of the week. Those who are at risk or fearful that they or their family might become sick are encouraged to join us for a Mass that is live-streamed online each weekend.

Appropriate social distancing and the regulations put forth by public health authorities must be observed. Here are the guidelines for Holy Rosary & St. Patrick.

- Entry doors will be open for you to have a *touch-free* entry into church.
- Hand sanitizer will be available as you enter. *Please use it.*
- You may wear a mask.
- Use all available (every other row will be marked for usage) space in the church. Families who have been in contact with each other may sit together. All others must be spaced at least 6 feet apart .
- No physical contact at the Our Father or Sign of Peace.
- No Holy Communion will be given from cups by the faithful. You will stay 6 feet apart from every individual as you approach for Communion, ushers will release you from pews. (A family with small children can approach together, keeping 6 feet from other parishioners.) There will be properly spaced Eucharistic ministers per section. Eucharistic ministers will do their best to drop the host into your hand without touching. (Eucharistic ministers will sanitize their hands & be wearing masks prior to distribution of communion.)
- There will be no missalettes or hymnals in the pews.
- The cry room will be available during Mass with proper social distancing.
- Collection baskets will not be passed during Mass. As you enter or exit Mass, please drop your envelopes into the basket in the entrances. We appreciate your gifts so much during this difficult time!
- Bulletins will be distributed as you leave and are also available online.
- The church will be sanitized after each Mass.

Please DO NOT congregate in the Vestibule or entrance ways in order to keep social distancing for all arriving & leaving

During the first two weeks of public Masses, we will be counting attendees and making any adjustments that are needed. So, we may have further changes and share additional communications on this.

Remember, the responsibility to keep others healthy is one that we all share. If you are sick or have been exposed to someone who is sick, please do not join us for Mass.

Most importantly, always be kind and patient. We are in a confusing and sometimes overwhelming situation. Your parish is doing its absolute best to help you, protect you and share our love for Christ with you. Please show your love of Christ by being Christ to others!
