## Message from the Pastor

Last week, I mentioned four things that athletes have to become the best they can be that Catholics often don't have. But these things would be good to have in order to become the best Catholics we can be. Last week, I recommended St. Francis de Sales as a coach. The next couple of weeks, I want to speak to the other three things: the reels, the game plans, and having a team to encourage us on to victory.

Recently, the parish purchased a subscription to the reels! [FORMED.org](http://FORMED.org) is a platform similar to YouTube or Netflix which contain videos on all sorts of topics on the Faith. Similar to how players have to know the fundamental principles of whatever sport that they're playing, Catholics need to know their Faith and the teachings of the Church. Not knowing those, we're like the player running aimlessly after the ball: tired, frustrated, and probably going to quit soon!

You might say, "I went to Holy Rosary..." or "I went to CCD... I already know the Faith..." But in many ways, that's like a high school player claiming that, since they were on the 8<sup>th</sup> grade team last year, they already know all the principles they need to know. But we all know that the senior varsity player should know the game better than an 8<sup>th</sup> grader. Just like we'd expect the senior varsity player to read the field better than the 8<sup>th</sup> grader, how much more for the Faith? There has to be that ongoing development of the understanding, otherwise, like the player, we begin to plateau in our relationship with the Lord.

And that's the beauty of FORMED. It provides a simple and free (to you) way to continue to grow in the knowledge of our Faith. The videos available on it are also geared towards people of all different levels. Maybe it's been a while since you've really dived into things and a refresher would be a good place to start. The *Symbolon* series provides a good overview of the Faith from start to finish. Maybe there's a specific topic that you're interested in diving into, like the Sacrament of Marriage. The *Beloved* series has two tracks: one for those preparing for marriage and one for those already married. It also has a bunch of great stuff for kids.

Just like a good athlete has to learn the fundamental principles of the game, Catholics need to know our Faith if we want to deepen it. Wherever you are in your faith journey, there's something on FORMED for you!
