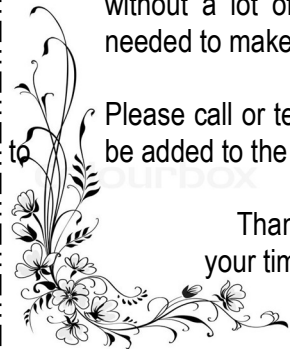

In your bi-monthly packet of envelopes there is a pink envelope for Friends of Holy Rosary. Any Catholic or Non-Catholic who is 18 years or older may be a member by paying the annual \$5 membership contribution per member. The annual membership contributions are used for operating expenses (postage, supplies, printing, etc.) and are not part of the trust. No monies donated to the trust may be used for operating expenses or spent. Annually, unused membership contributions are transferred to the trust fund. At the end of the fiscal year, the board of trustees of the organization directs that these monies earned the prior year to be given to Father for designated use as tuition assistance.

GUARDIAN PILGRIMS NEEDED

In celebration of the Bicentennial of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, the Archdiocese is planning a Marian Pilgrimage covering 300 miles to 36 different churches beginning May 16 and culminating with a reconsecration of our Archdiocese to Jesus through Mary on June 19 at St. Peter in Chains Cathedral.


In preparation for the Pilgrimage, the Archdiocese is seeking Adult Guardian Pilgrims, age 18 (who have graduated high school) and older who are physically able to carry in a team of 4, a 50 pound statue of Mary on a platform and walk 6-15 miles per day. Guardian Pilgrims must commit to 3 full days of the pilgrimage route. Overnight sleeping arrangements will vary from host parish to host parish - so accommodations can be anywhere from beds to sleeping bags on a parish center floor.

Pilgrims will be visiting Holy Rosary on May 19. We will host a Marian Procession with Holy Hour from 7-8pm on that evening. Watch the bulletin for other ways to prepare for this special bicentennial.

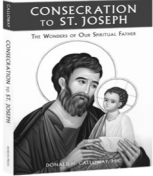
Lenten Diaper Drive
