### Meditations on Holy Mass

#### Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year A)

18 October 2020

**First reading:** Isaiah 45.1, 4-6 CCC 304\*

*I have grasped the right hand of Cyrus, to subdue nations before him.*

**Second reading:** 1 Thessalonians 1.1-5ab

*We remember your work of faith and labour of love and steadfastness of hope.*

**Gospel:** Matthew 22.15-21 CCC 2242

*Give to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's.*

In the *first reading*, the Prophet shows how the one, true God includes even those who do not know him into the history of salvation. In his *Gospel*, St. Matthew hands on the teaching of Jesus, that all authority worthy of the name comes from God. Civil rulers, no less than citizens, must give to God the things that are God's. God our Father has created all that exists both for his glory and for our happiness. In the *second reading*, St. Paul shows that our religious belief goes along with deeds at the service of the community.

**Before Mass:** *Master, we know that you are an honest man and teach the way of God in an honest way. (First Vespers)*

**After Mass:** *Let all men know from the rising to the setting of the sun that, apart from me, all is nothing. I am the Lord: there is no other. (Lauds)*

**Later in the day:** *Give back to Caesar what belongs to Caesar – and to God what belongs to God. (Second Vespers)*

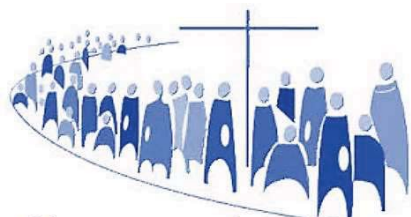

### Message from the Rector

Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

With the designation of the Ottawa region as a “red zone” by the provincial government in order to control the spread of Covid-19 infections, it is a reminder to us of our need to be vigilant about the public health guidance that we have received in recent months: physical distancing of 2 m/6 feet; wearing of masks in the church; and, providing contact tracing information. I note again what I have said in recent months: I am grateful to our parishioners, and others who attend Masses at Saint Patrick’s, for their diligence in observing these requirements. The objective is to keep everyone healthy and safe, and to keep our churches open.

One immediate consequence of this movement to a red zone for the parish will be our need to reduce the number of face-to-face appointments that we welcome at the parish office. In addition, some of our parish activities have either been put on hold for the time being, or will be transitioning to a virtual platform. This is not ideal but is prudent given the current circumstances. We continue to work on the project of live streaming our Sunday Vigil Mass. We will not put the Mass online until we are satisfied as to its quality and reliability.

Next Thursday, October 22, is the Memorial of Saint Pope John Paul II. It is an optional memorial but it has become our practice at Saint Patrick’s to observe this celebration. Anyone who has a memory of the saintly Pope knows how he marked not only the Church, but also the world, with his proclamation of the Gospel and of the need to work for the dignity of every human person. It will only be with the passage of time, likely decades if not centuries, that the Church and history will truly understand the importance and impact of Saint John Paul II.
