Meditations on Holy Mass

Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year A)

First reading: 1 Kings 19.9, 11-13 CCC 332*. 2583*

Go and stand on the mountain before the Lord.

Second reading: Romans 9.1-5 CCC 839; 449*

I could wish that I myself were cut off from Christ for the sake of my own people.

Gospel: Matthew 14.22-33 CCC 448*

Lord, command me to come to you on the water.

In the *first reading* the sacred writer depicts upheaval in nature, but the prophet finds God only in the stillness of silence. In his *Gospel*, St. Matthew depicts the Apostles distressed by a storm. These men saw the Lord cure the sick and feed the five thousand. They are terrified now, but Peter recognizes the Lord and he begins to go toward him when Christ calls to Peter. When the storm distracts Peter, he begins to sink, but Jesus reaches out to Peter, saves him, and calms the storm. Our temptation to fall arises from lack of trust in God. Tempted, we look to our own strengths, or to others' around us. When we go to God in prayer, we conquer temptation. In the *second reading*, St. Paul bears "great sorrow", but he declares "God be blessed for ever".

Before Mass: *After sending the crowds away Jesus went up into the hills by himself to pray. When evening came, he was there alone. (First Vespers)*

After Mass: *Jesus spoke to his disciples, who were terrified, "Have confidence, it is I; do not be afraid." (Lauds)*

Later in the day: *Lord, command me to come to you on the water. And, holding out his hand, he took hold of Peter; and he said to him, "You of little faith, why did you doubt?" (Second Vespers)*
