### Meditations on Holy Mass

#### Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year B)

**First reading:** Jeremiah 23.1-6

*I myself will gather the remnant of my flock and raise up shepherds over them.*

**Second reading:** Ephesians 2.13-18 CCC 2305

*Christ is our peace; in his flesh he has made both groups into one.*

**Gospel:** Mark 6.30-34

*They were like sheep without a shepherd.*

In the *first reading*, the prophet denounces religious leaders who have betrayed God's people. In a promise of hope, God's messenger foretells a time when his people will receive "justice and righteousness in the land." In his *Gospel*, centuries later, St. Mark tells us that Jesus also sees God's people as "sheep without a shepherd." Jesus does not bring punishment, but instead has compassion for these lost sheep. In the *second reading*, St. Paul explains that Jesus is "our peace; in his flesh he has made both Jews and Gentiles into one and has broken down ... the hostility between us." In Christ Jesus, the true Good Shepherd, everyone has "access in one Spirit to the Father." Let us resolve to put away hostility and, in reconciliation with one another and with Christ, approach our common Father, our mighty God.

**Before Mass:** *The Apostles gathered around Jesus and told him all that they had done and taught. (First Vespers)*

**After Mass:** *The disciples went out and preached that all must do penance. (Lauds)*

**Later in the day:** *The disciples cast out many demons and anointed with oil many who were sick and these were healed. (Second Vespers)*
