RIGHT TO LIFE RAFFLE

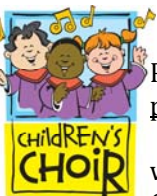

AED'S SAVE LIVES



AED (automated external defibrillator) is a portable medical device designed to recognize and treat potentially lethal heart rhythms during cardiac arrest. They deliver an electrical shock that can jump-start a heart or reestablish a normal heart rate to save someone's life.

It's time our parish purchased an AED. They run about \$1200. If anyone would like to help finance the purchase of an AED, please call Father Carina at the parish office sometime soon. Any size donation is welcomed.

We also welcome the involvement of any medical professional in the parish to help us maintain the AED and train volunteers in its use.



PRIESTS OF TOMORROW

Our diocese currently has 18 young men studying for the priesthood. They vary in age and background. One of our newest seminarians is just 18 years old and hails from South Amboy. Another is 41 years old and has a background in computer science.

The diocese operates the St. John Vianney House of Discernment in Highland Park for those who are still searching their hearts as to whether God is calling them to the priesthood. One of those living at the house of discernment is a 25 year old man from Vietnam who is taking English language courses at Rutgers with the hope of becoming a priest in the United States, hopefully, in our diocese.
