SOCIETY OF ST. ANTHONY OF PADUA

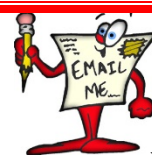

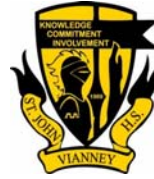
