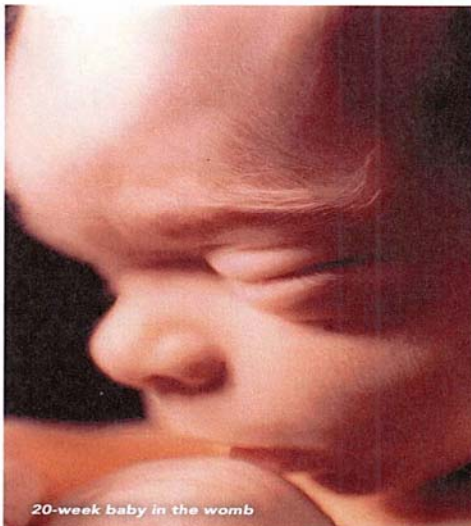


**IN GOD'S IMAGE**
