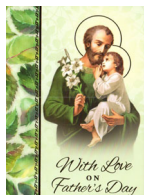

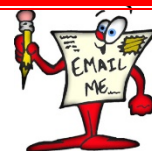

WE NEED YOU!



1. **Altar Linen Ministry:** Consists of washing, ironing and folding the various linens used in the celebration of Mass. You will be instructed in the proper way to treat and fold the cloths. It requires a commitment of one month a year on a rotating schedule. There are no meetings. All work is done in your home.

2. **Ushers:** sometimes called the "face" of the parish, ushers are the official greeters who help welcome people, seat parishioners at Mass, maintain order in church and take up the collection. Ushers need to arrive about 20 minutes before their scheduled Mass and stay around for a few minutes afterwards to check on the overall appearance of the church. A schedule is provided by the head usher and there are no meetings unless a special occasion would require such.

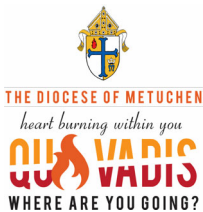
