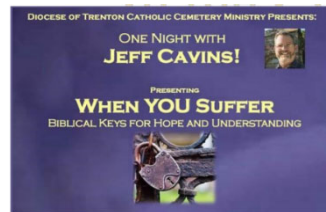
MOST HOLY REDEEMER PRAYER GROUP
