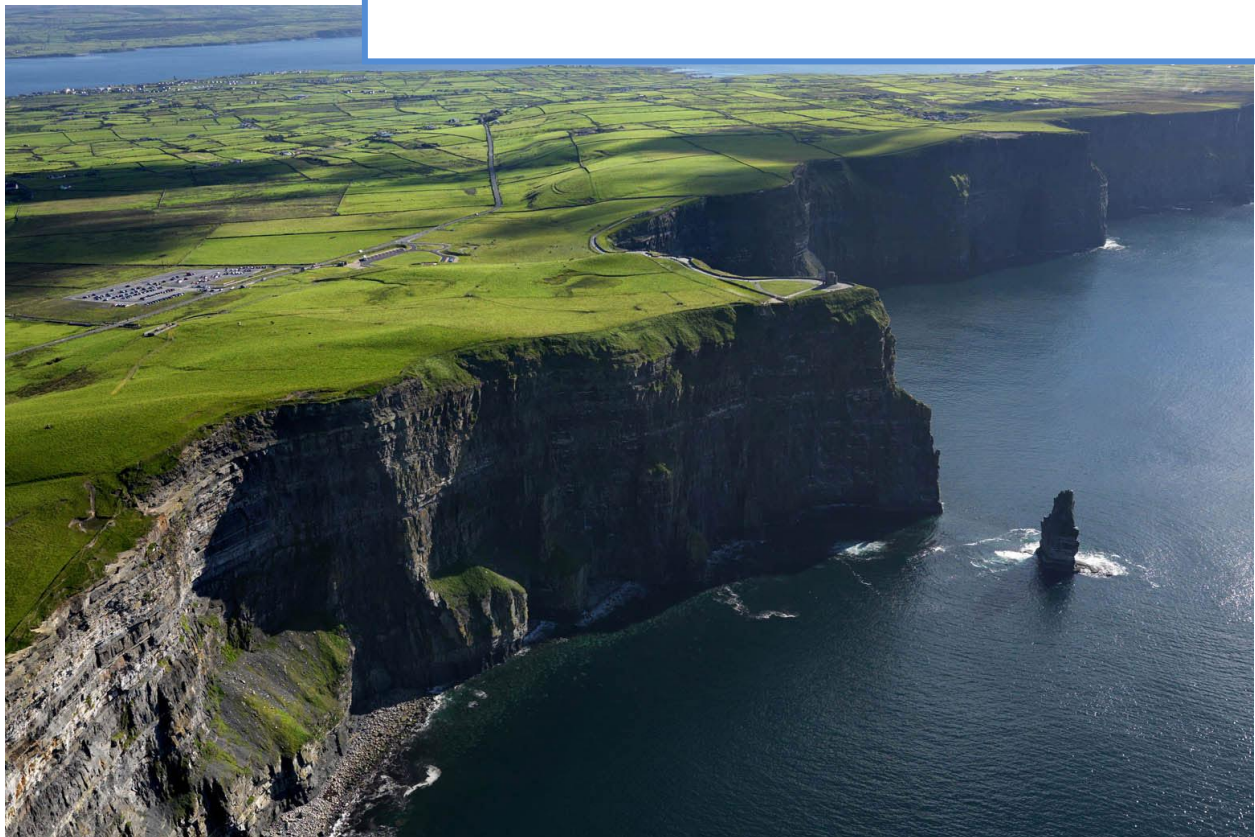




THE CLIFFS OF MOHER



The Cliffs of Moher, God's gift in nature, rise vertically to a height of 650 feet over the crashing waves of the Atlantic Ocean. They span eight miles and are the steepest cliffs in Ireland. Ancient rivers laid down sediments on the sea bed to form the rocks of the Cliffs of Moher which are sandstone, siltstone, and shale. The Cliffs of Moher are home to 40,000 birds from 29 different species including puffins. Sea birds may be found and viewed along the rock shelves in the cliffs. Over a million visitors view these extraordinary picturesque cliffs each year.
