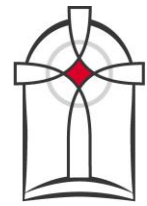

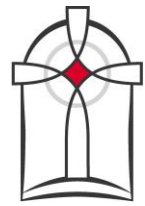

Information sharing from Fr. Sean

- DSF Appeal - Every parish in the archdiocese participates. The goal for CtR is \$305,000 which is based on average of the offertory collection over the last 3 years. These funds support the ministries of the diocese.
- Ash Wednesday is February 14. CtR is kicking off Lent with the Parish Mission, "Responding to the Spirit" on Feb 19-21. Fr. Bruce Neili, CSP will be leading CtR in the Mission. There will be a morning and evening session each day. All ministries at CtR will be involved in the parish mission. The PPC will be doing the opening prayer on 2/19. The Mission is spiritually driven. It is a time to reengage at the beginning of Lent.
- Redeemer Activities Center: Construction is on track with the substantial completion date in early June. The RAC will be ready for school to begin in August. On track, on time and on budget. The auditorium will have theater seats that will seat 650. This auditorium will host a variety of speakers to help people grow in faith and other ways.
- Adoration Chapel: A subcommittee is being formed to discuss the change from Perpetual Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament (which is what CtR currently has) to Perpetual Adoration (in the presence of the blessed sacrament). Change is never easy, so educating the parish on this change is important.
- CtR Festival dates April 28-29, 2018. Council members will help staff the ticket booth along with members of the other leadership positions.

Open Discussion

- A Stewardship Committee is in the process of being formed.
- People may be added to the CtR prayer list by calling the CtR office and sharing the name of the person you would like to have on the prayer list - a form will be completed and sent to the correct administrative person.
 - Eventually CtR would like to have a director of social ministry. Someone to help facilitate needs within the parish and to help with social outreach in the community.
- The new tax laws should not impact the giving at CtR.
- PPC Installment Mass has been rescheduled for Sunday, February 11 at 9am
- Penance Service is on Tuesday evening, March 13
- The 2020 Vision for CtR will be discussed at the next meeting - looking at goals and priorities of our parish.
