**PPC Matters:**

- Adoration Chapel: no update as of today. Fr. Sean will ask Deacon Jeff to come to our next meeting to update us. Deacon Jeff is working on choosing committee members, and this group will form after Easter.
- Stewardship Committee: Fr sean will follow up for our April meeting.
- 20/20 vision for CTR: Catholic Leadership Institute dates will be April 16, 17 (Monday/Tuesday) and will include 3 additional days to be scheduled with The Vision Committee to get details coordinated. Trisha Cellucci will facilitate the staff development meeting.

#### **Open Discussion:**

- Fr. Sean brought an article he recently read titled: *Cultures of Formation: Young People, the Faith and Vocational Discernment*. Written by Leonard J. DeLorenzo this article included his "six initial reflections" he had following the Cultures of Formation conference hosted by the McGrath Institute for Church Life (cosponsored by the [United States Conference of Catholic Bishops ] committee on doctrine). This article was most interesting as it relayed back to the committee's last meeting where we expressed the Parish's desire to get our youth more involved with their faith. Fr. Sean highlighted some of the points that really stood out to him and encouraged us to read the article in it's entirety as well as look up some of the links to other talks, videos, and articles from the conference.
