PPC Matters: Introduced Angelo Luna, seminarian from CTR. In residence this summer at the Rectory.

Thanks to those who volunteered at the Parish festival!

Open Forum: No parishioners were in attendance to address the council.

Information sharing from Fr. Sean:

- Festival Weekend: Brought in \$247k which was the 2nd highest ever. \$1325 was brought in for the PPC basket. Fr Sean donated wine from his collection and \$14,500 was raised! Thank you Fr Sean for your donation.
- Construction update: The construction trailer will be moved off property next week and the offices inside the building will be used. Still on pace to open this summer with the construction set to wrap up the end of June. The new building is on schedule to be used with the youth at the beginning of the fall.

Additionally, we are looking to redo the front driveway so it can be used both ways and won't bottom out cars. Bids are also in for a covered walkway between the 2 buildings. The covered walkway project may be something that is completed over the next few years.

- A date for the blessing and dedication of the new building with Cardinal DiNardo has not been scheduled yet.
- The 10th anniversary dedication celebration of the new church is planned for November. The celebration will be Sunday November 18th. Fr. Sean welcomes ideas on ways to commemorate this occasion.
- Discussion regarding an upcoming Speaker series, specifically having Christopher West at Prince of Peace, sponsored by CTR and PoP. Additionally, there is an upcoming concert in partnership with St. Anthony's, Christ the Good Shepherd, and Prince of Peace benefitting St. Ignatius of Loyola, on Friday June 27, with John Michael Talbot. The Speaker Series sub committee is also looking into getting Matt Fradd to come speak.
- 2020 Vision for CTR: Dates for envisioning committee - Summer 2018 still finalizing dates for late June or July.
- Stewardship committee - No updates today.
- Follow up from last meeting: Linda Watson, Director of Nursery Operations has implemented her new plan. Deacon Jeff Willard and the Adoration Chapel Committee has met a few times to discuss future plans.

Open Discussion:

- All departments are in summer mode. The CTR Youth are VERY busy.
- Suggestions received from the committee for installing hand rails by the Genesis building where the three steps are; putting in a sidewalk around circular drive and putting in additional wheelchair ramps so there are ramps at each end.
