Informational Sharing

- Parish Update from Fr. Sean:

RAC: The dedication went well. We received good feedback from the community and Cardinal DiNardo loved the building. The gym floor is now complete. The bleachers and padding are being installed in the next few days and the final punch list items are getting addressed. Coach Leach said that the gym should be ready for use after Labor Day. A final walk is scheduled for 9/7/2018.

20/20 Vision for CtR: Met with Tricia Cellucci on Aug. 13. On Sept 26 &27, she will return with the Catholic Leadership Institute. The online survey and phone interviews from the parish will be discussed to see what the parishioners would like to see here at CtR in the future.

10th Anniversary of the Church: The anniversary celebration will be the weekend of Nov. 17. The full weekend begins Friday with Solemn Prayer. On Saturday morning there will be a Rosary, followed by the Parish Wide Service Project. Sunday, Bishop George Sheltz will celebrate the 9am mass. Then at 2pm there will be a concert in the Church. Currently in the planning stages is a cupcake celebration after the Sunday morning masses. At the September meeting we will review ideas on how to mark this occasion (possible commemorative ornament).

- Adoration Chapel Committee: Deacon Jeff Willard is no longer the Director of Liturgy. Therefore, Fr. Sean will head up this committee. He plans to come back to this matter after Labor Day.
- The International Catholic Stewardship Council Conference is in late October, in Nashville, TN. Attendees from the parish will include Fr. Sean, Ashley Bass and Megan Dillingham.

Open Discussion:

- Now that school is in session, the side exit is now 2 way traffic and nicely marked with signage. It will be repainted so arrows are going the right way.
- We have approximately 442 total students. It is the school's 5th year open and is now one of the largest in the diocese.
- Fr. Sean welcomed feedback regarding the message from last weekend's homily on the scandal of abuse in the Church.
