**Information sharing from Fr. Sean & Dcn Kerry:**

- Parish update Vision 20/20 Journey with Jesus: The Vision 20/20 was announced at mass to introduce the parish to the three themes to fulfill this vision.
- Saturday, January 26, 2019, will be our Day of Prayer from 830a-12p. The hope

is for every ministry to have at least 1 representative to reflect, pray and dig deeper into the plans for our Vision 20/20. This event will take place in the youth suite in the RAC. So far, there have been many rsvp's.

- Dcn Kerry updated the council on the RAC stating that punchlist & warranty items are almost complete. The covered walkway is finished except for the lighting. There will be security fencing to encompass the south corner of the PLC, and the back side of the RAC. An energy audit is being conducted and we are implemented many of those suggestions. The leaks in church are also being investigated.
- An Annulment workshop is being held this Saturday morning, January 26, 2019, led by Fr. Richard Wahl, C.S.B.
