PPC Matters:

Spring Festival results:

- This past festival was the 5th best in CTR's 34 years, and netted over \$227,000 for the parish. No complications were reported and our vehicle winner was a CTR parishioner.
- Continued discussion around a transition team to assist the Havelkas in writing down the festival planning and execution process for a future transition.
- The bbq sales didn't make as much as in past, most likely due to more competition and options available. PPC member, Matt Lane, helped lead the bbq team dinner. He reported there were many open slots for kitchen help, and the team hired 3 people from Millsap Elementary to help in kitchen and they were great with helping things run smoothly. There were no volunteers to man

the tea as they ran out of volunteers. The to go boxes for families to take meals home was successful.

- The auction was scaled back this year. Reviewing some silent auction ideas for next year like: bidding ideas, new items, and even a buy it now option.

Open Forum: No members from the parish were in attendance to address the council.

Information sharing from Fr. Sean & Dcn Kerry:

- CTR will be hosting a Seminarian this summer. Joey White arrives in June and will be here through August.
- Happy to have two young men from CTR accepted into the seminary. One will attend Holy Trinity Seminary in Dallas and another will attend Saint Joseph Seminary College in Louisiana.
- CTR will host an Andrew Dinner for high school boys considering the seminary. This is in response to the Office of Vocations of the Archdiocese asking some area parishes to host on site.
- Seven men are being ordained to the priesthood in our archdiocese.
- Excited to announce Ashley Bass has been hired as our Director of Stewardship. As part of our parish Vision 20/20, this new position and council will focus on all aspects of stewardship in and around the parish. Ashley will join the PPC at our August meeting to explain further their mission and plans. Currently in the planning stages: Aug. 25 will be a mini parish mission and event with Fr. Jim Sichko, known for his presentations, "60 minutes with Jesus." The kickoff to the 3 day event will begin after the 11:00am mass.
- Our first Welcome Sunday was recently held and there were 18 new families who attended. These Welcome Sundays are planned for one per month, with the help of the Welcoming Committee and the Stewardship Committee. Next one is September 8th.
- Vacation bible school is set to begin, and all morning slots are full.
- Catholic Faith Camp is set for July, geared toward our middle schoolers.
- Genesis reports 23 spots left. The 2 and 4 yr classes are full. The openings are in

3 and below 2. The program is capped at 258.

- Formation Toward Christian Ministry (FTCM), is returning to Christ the Redeemer. We will be hosting one semester of the three semester program each summer for the next three years. The first semester, will be offered 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m., Monday, July 22nd through Friday, July 26th in the Parish Hall.
- The CTRCS has a projected enrollment of 416 for the fall. They anticipate a large 8th grade class. The school has hired a parttime bookkeeper, with Nora, the Parish Business Manager having oversight.
