PPC Matters:

- Fr. Sean would like to discuss the article from the University of Notre Dame at the May meeting. Please read the article and be prepared for an open discussion.

Open Forum: No members from the parish were in attendance to address the council.

Information sharing from Fr. Sean:

- Covid Pandemic – When will the parish be ‘back to normal’? When can the ministries begin in person meetings? Cardinal Di Nardo has not announced any changes from his previous statements regarding the number of attendees. Fr. Sean surveyed his fellow priests and the consensus was to bring back in person sooner than later. The question is when should CTR? May 1 or Pentecost Sunday (the birth of the church)? Deacon Kerry provided protocols for On-Site in- person meetings. There are rooms available based on the number of

attendees. Ideas were maybe to change the 6 ft apart to 4 ft apart in order to accommodate more attendees and keep a roster of attendees in order to notify those IF there is an exposure to the virus. Masks will be required for all attending regardless of being vaccinated or not, no food/drinks can be served.

- Wednesday night RCIA (inquiry) stopped in-person meeting because attendance was low. Many found the on-line, at home on-line, is more convenient.
- Fr. Sean and Fr. Vincent are seeing an increase in parishioner counseling due to the pandemic.
- Many parishioners express appreciation and excitement to be back at mass in person.
- Cardinal Di Nardo has not lifted the dispensation for not attending mass.
- There have been no updates from the Cardinal regarding increasing capacity for mass. We are still holding to 50%.
- VBS will be virtual this summer. Registration will start this week. VBS is July 12 – 16, cost \$10
- Spring Festival – Most of the food tickets are sold out! Some even added more to accommodate the demand. All is going very well so far.
- The position for Director of Audio/Visual productions and IT support has been filled. Omar Flores started April 1st. He will direct/coordinate live stream and assist Tony with IT for the parish and school.
- Deacon Kerry – RAC repairs – Deacon and Fr Sean are reviewing the bids received for the repairs. Mostly cosmetic, base boards, carpet and painting, the repairs will be done during the summer after the last day of school (June 11).
