In the meantime, please consider bringing your family to Mass every Sunday. If that's truly not possible (*due to Covid 19 concerns*), then make sure to set aside one hour every Sunday when everyone sits down together and watches a televised Mass at home. Afterward, discuss the readings and homily.

There are countless resources online. For example, Sermons4Kids.com has simple lessons and activities based on the Gospel reading for each Sunday. Remember that your home is a domestic church, and **you are the first and best teachers of the faith!**
