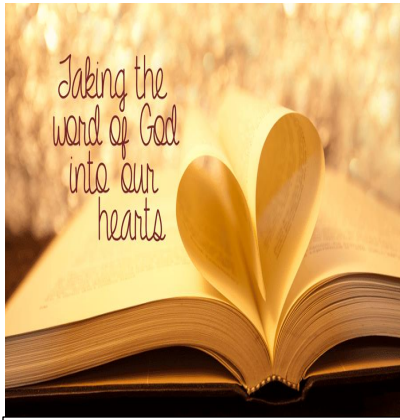

IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY

The Catholic Church honors Mary, Mother of God on the 1st day of January, under the title of St. Mary, Mother of God. For this reason this article tends to honor her asking her help and intercession throughout this coming Year 2017.

IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY. In the picture of this devotion, Mary points to her Heart, A Heart that is in flame of the divine love, a Heart that pierced by a sword, invites us to live, along with her, the path of Love and Cross (in other words loving God, we accept the suffering, life brings to us)

The memory of her Immaculate Heart leads us in a direct and mysterious way to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. It is that everything in Mary directs us to her Son. The Hearts of Jesus and Mary are marvelously united in time and eternity.

The Church teaches us that the most secure way to reach Jesus is by way of his Mother, In order to follow the recommendation of the Church, we consecrate ourselves to the Sacred Heart of Jesus by means of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. This truth can be confirmed in the Liturgy, in celebrating both feast days in a consecutive from, Friday and Saturday, in the week, following Sunday of Corpus Christi.

Holy Mary mediator of all graces invites us to put our trust in her maternal love, to direct our prayers asking her Immaculate Heart to help us to conform ourselves to her Son, Jesus Christ.

To venerate her Immaculate Heart means not only to honor her physical heart, but also her person as a fountain of all her virtues. We venerate her Heart as a symbol of her love for God and for all of us, her children.

Our Mother's Heart clearly shows us her answer to impulses of what She perceived by her profound purity in the authentic sense. She always chose with prudence and wisdom the concrete paths in the variety of different possibilities that everyday a human person encounters. Mary preserved of all stain of sin, by the grace of God, responds exemplary and straight forward to the orientation received according to God's Plan for her.

Mary who treasures and mediates all the signs of God in her Heart, calls us to make the effort to know our own heart, in other words the profound reality of our being, that mysterious part of ourselves where we encounter the divine presence that asks the full encounter with God's Love.

Let us honor our Immaculate Mother following her words and orientation and may we grow in the love for her and by her to her Son, our Lord Jesus Christ.

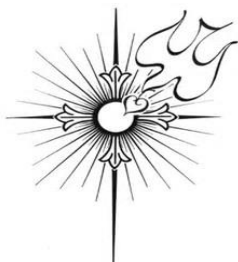
