For 77th Time, Ambulance Transports Woman from Planned Parenthood as Limited Abortions Resume in St. Louis

The question of abortion safety is so serious at the Reproductive Health Services Planned Parenthood abortion facility in St. Louis, Missouri, that the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services moved to revoke its facility license in 2019, after an investigation into a high number of medical emergencies revealed at least four women suffered life-threatening injuries from bungled abortions.

Missouri Administrative Court Commissioner Sreenivasa Rao Dandamudi chose to ignore the dangers uncovered by state investigators at RHS Planned Parenthood as well as the abortion business' attempts to stonewall a DHSS investigation. In May 2020, he issued a ruling that allowed the facility to stay open.

That video shows a woman covered with a sheet lying on a gurney as she is loaded into a St. Louis Fire Department ambulance parked near the Planned Parenthood facility's front door.

This is the seventy-seventh time such a medical emergency has been documented at the RHS Planned Parenthood in St. Louis. Barkledge told Operation Rescue that she recently received documentation through a public records request from the St. Louis Fire Department that showed as many as 81 women may have suffered abortion-related complications that required emergency ambulance transport from the RHS Planned Parenthood facility since 2009.

In 2018, Planned Parenthood of Greater St. Louis, which operates the St. Louis facility, moved all its chemical abortion appointments to an Illinois facility to avoid Missouri's strong abortion safety laws. Once their surgical facility in Fairview Heights, Illinois, opened in October 2019, all chemical and nearly all surgical abortion clients were sent to that location for the same reason.

By the end of 2020, Operation Rescue confirmed that no abortions of any kind were being done at the RHS Planned Parenthood facility in Missouri.

Earlier this year, the St. Louis Planned Parenthood resumed abortions on an extremely limited basis in response to a January 2021 report published by Operation Rescue that noted no abortions were available in Missouri at that time.

As of this writing, abortion appointments are difficult to get in St. Louis, and the vast majority of women seeking abortions are still being referred to the Fairview Heights facility.

Since Mondays are rarely abortion days, it is unknown why the Planned Parenthood client required emergency transport on March 15. If the emergency were abortion-related, it is possible it may have been related to a previous injury from an abortion that took place at their busy Fairview Heights facility.

“There is no reason to allow the dangerous St. Louis Planned Parenthood to continue harming women. It should have been shut down in 2019 when the state found it was too dangerous to operate. That Planned Parenthood is no better than a back-alley chop shop,” said Operation Rescue President Troy Newman. “If future performance can be predicted on past behavior, I guarantee this will not be the last woman harmed by RHS Planned Parenthood, as long as the state allows it to stay open, and that poses an unacceptable danger to the public.”

New Report Shows Teen Abortion Rate Has Dropped a Whopping 82%

The pro-choice Guttmacher Institute released long-term data on rates of pregnancies, births, and abortions in the U.S. The national data range from 1973 to 2017 and include breakdowns by age demographics, and the state-level data range from 1988 to 2017.

These statistics are especially helpful because, while the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) provide some information about the age demographics of women obtaining abortions, their data are incomplete. For instance, the CDC's 2018 Abortion Surveillance Report did not include data from California, Maryland, New Hampshire, and Wyoming.

As a result, this new Guttmacher report provides interesting information for understanding U.S. abortion trends. In 2012, my Lozier Institute colleague Susan Wills analyzed CDC data and found that the largest abortion-rate declines were taking place among younger age demographics.

These new data suggest that the trend is continuing, as the report shows that between 1980 and 2017, the abortion rate for females between the ages of 15 and 19 fell by more than 82 percent. The abortion rate for 35-to-39-year-olds fell by only 8.5 percent during the same timespan.

The large reduction in the teen abortion rate is partly the result of a higher percentage of pregnant teenagers choosing life for their preborn children. According to these new statistics, the percentage of pregnancies carried to term by women ages 15 to 19 between 1980 and 2017 increased by more than 10 percent.

An even more important reason for the drop in the teen abortion rate is that teenagers are now much less likely to become pregnant in the first place. According to Guttmacher, the teen pregnancy rate peaked in 1990 at 117.6 pregnancies per thousand teenaged females (girls 15 to 19). Since then, the teen pregnancy rate has declined by a whopping 73 percent.

This substantial long-term decline in the teen pregnancy rate in the United States is an important public-policy success story. Groups that support legal abortion and their allies in the mainstream media are quick to credit increases in contraception use for these changes. But even some left-wing media outlets such as Vox have admitted that there are other factors, such as the significant, durable, long-term decline in teenage sexual activity.

Alabama Passes Resolution to Lower Its Flags, Mourn 61 Million Babies Killed in Abortions

The Alabama Senate passed House Joint Resolution 24, recognizing January 22 as the Day of Tears. Sponsored by Representative Tommy Hanes (R-Bryant), this resolution calls for private citizens in Alabama to lower their flags on January 22, in honor and remembrance of the over 61 million innocents who have lost their lives to abortion.

The Senate joins the House, who passed the resolution on February 11th.



Premature Baby Girl Born Just Weeks After Abortion Limit is Doing Great

Parents of a premature baby have praised a new app that has allowed them to stay connected to their newborn daughter, Barbara, despite the lockdown.

Barbara was born at 27 weeks' gestation – just three weeks after the abortion limit – in Kent in September last year and was transferred twice to Evelina London Children's Hospital for her care.

Due to the COVID lockdowns, parents Jenny Clarke and John Britton have had to make use of a video messaging app called vCreate in order to receive updates on their daughter's progress.

"As we don't live close to the hospital, we rely on public transport to visit Barbara, which has been especially difficult over the past few months", Jenny said.

"The app has been a brilliant way for us to see Barbara and check in on her progress".



Supreme Court Could Take Mississippi Abortion Ban Case That Challenges Roe v. Wade

For more than six months, the U.S. Supreme Court has been delaying a decision about a Mississippi pro-life law that bans abortions after 15 weeks.

And on Monday, it did so again.

Last summer, Mississippi Attorney General Lynn Fitch, the first female to hold the position, asked the Supreme Court to hear the case and allow the state to protect unborn babies from abortions.

But the justices have not issued a decision about whether they even want to hear the case, *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization*.

Initially, National Review writer Ed Whelan expressed optimism about the case, arguing that it could be "the best opportunity the Supreme Court will ever have to overturn *Roe v. Wade*."

He pointed out that the high court has a 6-3 conservative majority, and the case presents an opportunity for the justices to overturn or at least roll back *Roe*.

Most Americans support strong limits on abortions after the first trimester, and upholding the Mississippi law would allow states to enact laws that reflect that consensus, he said. Currently, under *Roe* and *Planned Parenthood v. Casey*, states are prohibited from banning abortions prior to viability.

Whelan said most European countries also prohibit or strongly limit abortions after 15 weeks of pregnancy. So, the Mississippi law is far from extreme.

Arizona Bill Would Ban Abortions, Charge Abortionists With Homicide for Killing Babies

Arizona is one of several states this spring that is considering legislation to completely ban abortions.

The State Press reports Rep. Walter Blackman, R-Snowflake, introduced a bill in January to declare that unborn babies are “persons” with legal rights from the moment of conception.

His pro-life bill, House Bill 2650, recognizes that a unique, living human being comes into existence at the moment of conception, and that human being deserves the same rights, guaranteed under the 14th Amendment, as any other person. It would ban abortions and allow abortionists who kill unborn babies to be charged with homicide.

Blackman said his bill also includes resources to help mothers and babies in difficult circumstances, according to the report. He said he amended the bill to include these resources and to remove language that would have allowed mothers to be charged with homicide as well as abortionists.

“I amended the bill to take the mother out of the equation when we’re talking about the law or being consequences under the law,” Blackman said. “The original bill said that the mother would be placed in jail. I disagree with that because there are other situations that may happen where that mother just cannot handle the pregnancy or handle the birth of the baby.”

The state lawmaker said he is especially troubled by the abortion rate in the African American community and the abortion industry’s targeting of unborn black babies and mothers.

Noting Planned Parenthood founder Margaret Sanger’s discriminatory beliefs, he said there are “more Planned Parenthoods in black communities” today and “more ads that are directed to the black community to abort their baby rather than try to save their baby.”

Planned Parenthood closes three centers in Washington State

Planned Parenthood of the Great Northwest and Hawaiian Islands has closed three of its medical centers in the state of Washington. Its Kent and Shelton locations closed as well as its First Hill Center at 1229 Madison Street in Seattle. All three centers committed surgical and/or pill abortions.

News reports of the closures say that Planned Parenthood is blaming “low reimbursement rates from the state Medicaid program” as the reason for the closures. Planned Parenthood told reporters that it is “hoping the Legislature will take action in the coming weeks to increase the state’s Medicaid reimbursement rates for family planning services.” If lawmakers do not do so, Planned Parenthood said as many as six of its other clinics across the state are at risk of closure. Planned Parenthood began 2021 with 33 centers in the state.

All three of these locations are “permanently closed” according to Planned Parenthood’s website. There is some indication that Planned Parenthood’s closure of the three centers may have been politically motivated. There is currently a struggle in the state legislature over family planning reimbursement rates. Governor Jay Inslee has proposed an increase but is meeting resistance. State Rep. Nicole Macri (D-Seattle) is working to ensure the Legislature includes the rate increase for family planning clinics in the state’s new two-year budget. She told reporters “the pattern in the Legislature is to adjust Medicaid rates only when there is some sort of crisis, such as a loss of providers that

cuts access to certain services in broad areas of the state. She said the recent closures of the Planned Parenthood health centers show that money for family planning services has reached that kind of crisis point.”

Whatever the reason, Planned Parenthood has permanently closed these three centers—and that is good news.

Autopsy Report Reveals Alabama Woman Died of Perforated Uterus During Abortion

A woman who died after leaving the West Alabama Women’s Center (WAWC) abortion facility in Tuscaloosa, Alabama on May 7, 2020, has been identified through her autopsy report as 29-year-old April Lowery.

The report was obtained by the CEC for Life on behalf of a coalition of national and local pro-life groups that also includes Operation Rescue, Life Legal Defense Foundation, and Pro-Life Tuscaloosa.

Lowery was seen on May 7, 2020, leaving the WAWC by pro-life activists, who described her as “sick and pale.” She had to be physically supported as she struggled to walk from the clinic to an awaiting private vehicle, which then reportedly transported her to what is believed to have been UAB Hospital in Birmingham, where she was later pronounced dead.

The cause of death listed on Lowery’s autopsy report was “Uterine perforation,” a known complication to surgical abortions.

Planned Parenthood Wants to Allow Nurses to Kill Babies in Abortions

Nebraska state Senator Megan Hunt has introduced a bill to allow non-physicians to commit abortions. Hunt hasn’t been shy about prioritizing her friends at Planned Parenthood. The abortion behemoth, in turn, regularly praises Hunt in social media posts like this, this, this, and this. Hunt’s latest stunt, Legislative Bill 276, would ensure that women are even more endangered from undergoing abortion in the state of Nebraska than they already are, following in the footsteps of states like California and now Hawaii that also prioritize Planned Parenthood’s needs over women’s safety.

If Planned Parenthood gets its way, LB 276 will remove the requirement (under penalty of felony) that a physician carry out abortions. Physician requirements don’t prevent babies from being killed, but only govern who can do the killing. They exist as a women’s safety measure, making it puzzling to some why the purportedly “pro-woman” abortion lobby would oppose them. The reality is that anti-abortion advocates care about the health and safety of both children and women — and champion protections for both — while abortion industry is concerned with only their profit margins.

Nebraska’s Planned Parenthood demonstrated its antipathy toward women when it allegedly sold abortion drugs to a rapist posing as his pregnant victim’s father (which should not have been possible under the verification measures mandated by Nebraska’s parental consent law). According to the Omaha World-Herald, the teen told police that her abuser, a school janitor, “pretended to be her father and took her to Planned Parenthood to obtain an abortion pill, something that later was corroborated by medical records.” Failing abuse victims and breaking the law is Planned Parenthood’s established M O.

EDITOR'S COMMENTS

When Defenders of the Unborn announced that Planned Parenthood was no longer doing abortions. We didn't do this hap hazard. We had evidence that they were not doing abortions in St. Louis but sending victims to Fairview Heights, IL abortion mill. We knew that they could at any time begin again. We did ask prayer warriors to continue to have a presence at this mill.

Planned Parenthood doesn't want Missouri to be the first abortion free state so they began again killing babies. Our task is to continue to be a witness at this mill until the gates are locked and the building is sold. The only way that we can accomplish this is by having a constant presence there. Our mission is not finished.

It is sad that some pro-life leaders do not want to work with other organizations. They refuse to work together. We will NEVER end this senseless killing if we continue to speak negative of others who are working as they feel called to do.

Sidewalk counseling is vital. We need good sidewalk counselors to know what is needed to support the mom going in. If you are going to sidewalk counsel you need to know what your literature says and know where to take this mom if needed. Read and become familiar with the literature you distribute to the moms going in. You need to know what the client is going in for. Birth control, pregnancy test or an abortion. Then you will be able to help them. A tip don't ask if the person want s the information. That gives them the chance to say "No thanks." Smile and continue to be assertive, and offer the literature with words such as, " we have important information that should have before you go in." Your goal is to get the literature to them in order for them to see what they are about to do and to see that their is help for them.

If you able to continue talk to the mom ask them, Do you know if your baby is a boy or girl? Do you have names picked out? Just think, your baby next year at this time will be walking and maybe calling you dad or mom. You can be putting bows in her hair or playing with him, dad. Your baby doesn't want to die today. Your baby will feel pain during the abortion. These statements gives the baby re-humanize the baby. You can't read from a script you need to allow the Holy Ghost to lead you!

Many girls are going by Uber, Lyft or a cab. Give that literature to the driver, and encourage them to give it to the client they are bringing to the abortion mill.

Currently in the U.S., about 40% of abortions are being done by the abortion pill, which means you have the opportunity to persuade the woman to try to save her baby even after she took the first pill. Tell her not to take the second pill that she is to take after leaving the abortion mill. Ask her or you contact for her –www.abortionpillreversal.com. I know that this works because Defenders of the Unborn has a mom who will deliver her baby in three weeks who took that first pill and realized that it was a mistake. She called us and we put her in contact with our doctor. God is Good!

If you are going to be a sidewalk counselor you MUST arm yourself with fact and know that each mom has a different need. Find out why that moms is there, what brought her to this place of death. And give her what is needed to prevent the death of her child.
