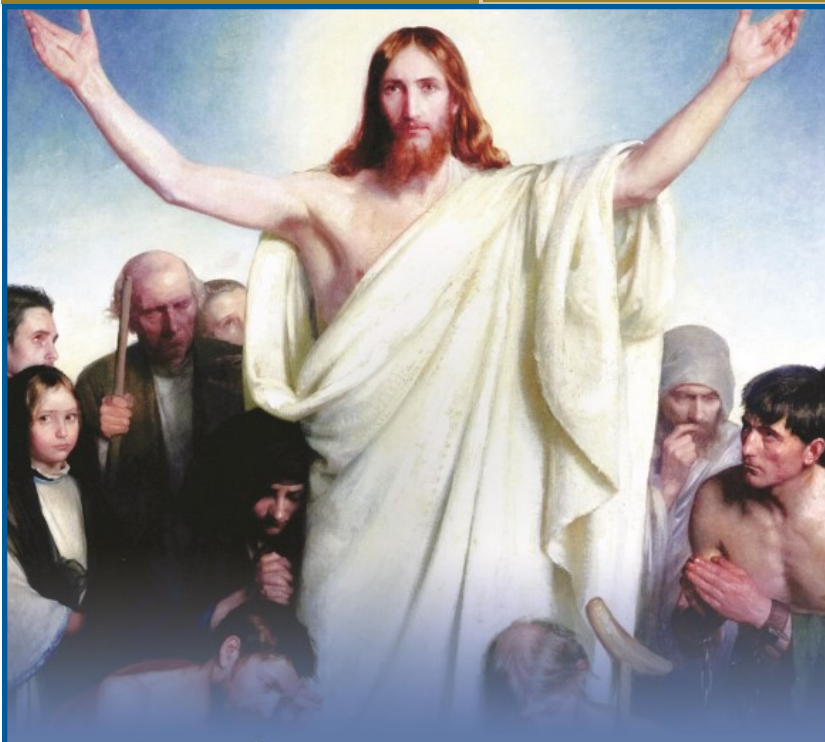

Grant freedom to all, and give us the strength to protect the rights of others. Amen



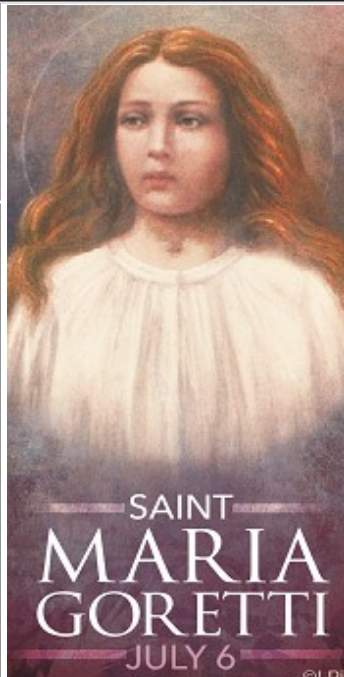

Maria Goretti (October 16, 1890 - July 6, 1902) was an Italian virgin-martyr of the Catholic Church, and one of the youngest saints to be canonized. She was beatified in 1947, and canonized in 1950.

She was born to a farming family. Her father died when she was nine, and they had to share a house with another family. Maria took over household duties while her mother, brothers, and sister worked in the fields.

Maria may have had trouble with catechism, but she had no trouble with **faith**. God's will was holiness, decency, respect for one's body, absolute obedience, total trust. In a complex world, her faith was simple: It is a privilege to be loved by God, and to love him—at any cost.

Maria's feast day, celebrated on July 6<sup>th</sup>. She is the patron saint of chastity, rape victims, girls, youth, teenage girls, poverty, purity, and forgiveness.

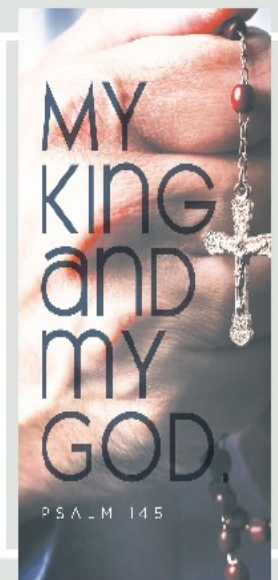

**FIRST READING**

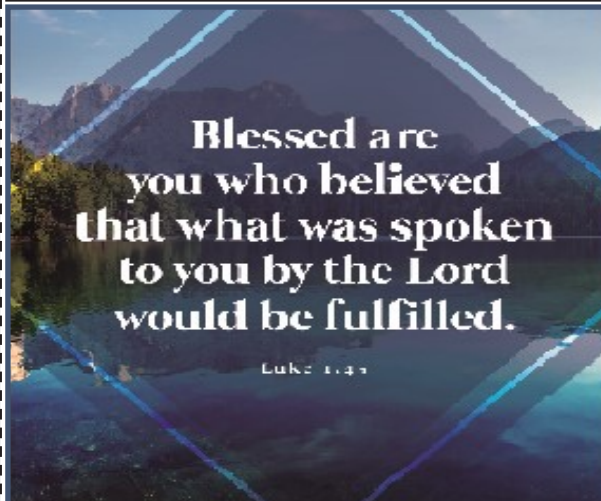
The prophet Zechariah envisioned a future king for the people of Israel who would rule the nations with justice and humility. How do you see these virtues as a strength in leadership?
