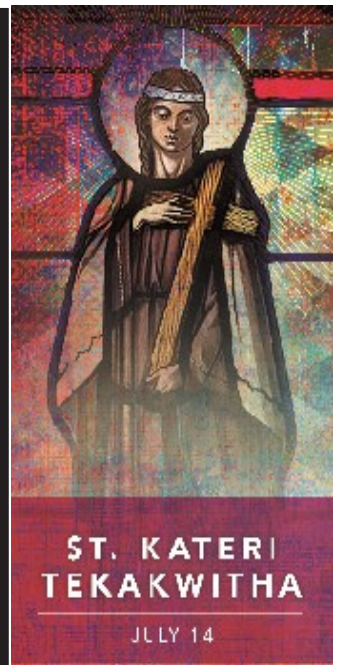

Kateri Tekakwitha, baptized as Catherine and informally known as Lily of the Mohawks, is a Catholic saint who was an Algonquin-Mohawk.

She was born in 1656 and contracted smallpox in an epidemic; her family died and her face was scarred. She converted to Catholicism at age nineteen. Refusing to marry, she left her village and moved for the remaining five years of her life in a Jesuit mission village in Canada. Tekakwitha took a vow of perpetual virginity. Upon her death at the age of 24, witnesses said that minutes later her scars vanished and her face appeared radiant and beautiful.

Known for her virtue of chastity and mortification of the flesh, as well as being shunned by some of her tribe for her religious conversion to Catholicism, she is the fourth Native American to be venerated in the Catholic Church. St. Kateri Tekakwitha is the first Native American to be recognized as a saint by the Catholic Church.
