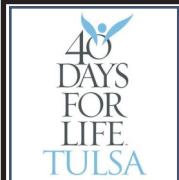

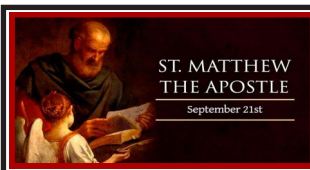

St. Matthew, the first-century tax collector turned apostle who chronicled the life and ministry of Christ in his Gospel, is celebrated by the Church on Monday, September 21st. Although relatively little is known about the life of St. Matthew, the account he wrote of Christ's ministry traditionally considered to be the first of the four Gospels - is of inestimable value to the Church, particularly in its verification of Jesus as the Messiah. His Gospels were written in Aramaic, the language that our Lord Himself spoke.
