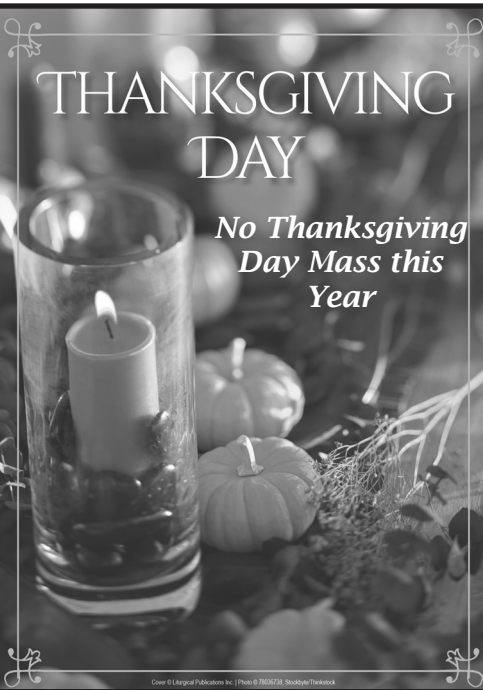
**SUPPORT OUR

Fr. Kingsley has just completed his fourth year as Pastor here at St. Joseph Church.

As you may or may not know, the St. Joseph Rectory has been in decline for many years. There have been some repairs done to the building over the years but not enough to fix the **structure** of the building. Since he moved here in August of 2016, Fr. Kingsley has noticed continued deterioration making the house uninhabitable.

The parish council has had much discussion whether to house Fr. Kingsley in an off-property home rental or to modify one of the buildings on the church grounds and it was decided to keep him housed on the property. In the interim, Fr. Kingsley will move to the CCD building behind the rectory. It should only take minimal funds to bring the building to a livable space. If you would like to donate to this new project, please mark your donation "Renovation Fund". This money will specifically be used for Fr. Kingsley's new living space. Please take an envelope on the table at the front of the church and prayerfully consider this project.

We feel it is our responsibility as good stewards to maintain our buildings and keep our grounds in good order. Thank You

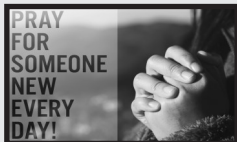
