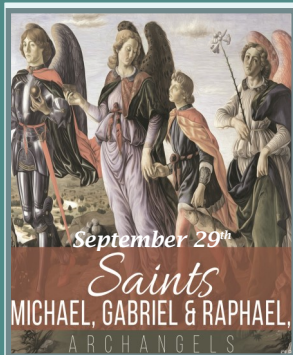

TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

September 26, 2021



The three Archangels; **Michael, Gabriel and Raphael** are the only Angels named in Sacred Scripture and all three have important roles in the history of salvation.

Saint Michael is the "Prince of the Heavenly Host," the leader of all the angels.

Saint Gabriel, whose name means "God's strength," announced the birth of John the Baptist and at the Incarnation of the Word in the womb of Mary.

Saint Raphael, whose name means "God has healed" is generally accepted by tradition to be that of healing and acts of mercy

NOVENA TO SAINT MICHAEL: As we approach the Feast of Saint Michael, Saint Gabriel and Saint Raphael, archangels on September 29th, pray the Novena to Saint Michael for the protection, healing, and unity of the Church. Subject: New COVID-19 Policies - Parish and Mass

The attached updated COVID-19 Parish and Mass guidelines have been harmonized with the policies governing our elementary schools and include the following important updates and recommendations:

1. The COVID-19 policies for Parishes and the separate Mass policy have now been combined into a single document for convenience sake;
2. New quarantine options pursuant to CDC guidance on masks & vaccines;
3. Face coverings (masks) are not and cannot be mandated save for a "special Mass" but are strongly recommended
4. Save concerns for quarantine, pastors should not inquire regarding vaccination status nor mandate vaccines
5. Vaccination is recommended
6. All diocesan waivers and permission forms include COVID-19 and are now available in English and Spanish ;
7. The rule on masks applies to Mass save a "special Mass," which can be an already existed less **attended** Mass;
8. Distribution of the Precious Blood remains suspended
9. The guidelines defer heavily to the pastors on most items (e.g., "may use reasonable efforts") given the various resources and facilities of our parishes.

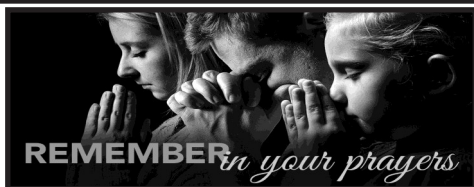
