**Mrs. Lizewski's 4th Grade School Supply List**

**Please put your child's name on all items**

A backpack and lunch box (if desired) with your child's name clearly labeled

Pencil pouch (please no plastic or metal boxes as they break open easily and take up more space)

Three to four boxes of pencils (These will be kept in the classroom closet and used as needed by your child.)

Pencil cap erasers or a large eraser

Two red pens for self-corrections

Box of 24 crayons, markers, OR colored pencils

A pencil sharpener that catches the shavings

Two to three glue sticks to start the year. Replenish as needed

Five 2-pocket folders

Package of wide-ruled loose-leaf paper

Scissors

Four hardcover marble composition notebooks

Three highlighters any color

Four black dry erase markers (Colors tend to stain and can be hard to see from a distance. The dollar store has these.)

An eraser for dry erase board (A sock or piece of microfiber cloth works great!)

Earbuds for computer use (These can be found at the dollar store!)

Three boxes of tissues

One container of baby wipes

One container of Clorox or Lysol wipes

***Donations/Class Wish List:***

Paper towels

Hand sanitizer

Napkins

**\*\*Please bring one HEALTHY snack (To name a few: fruit, cut vegetables, plain crackers, pretzels, yogurt, cheese sticks) and WATER ONLY each day. Reusable water bottles are ideal because they cut down on waste and stay cool longer. (From personal experience, you may want to check that the bottle is not too top heavy when empty to prevent breakage.)**
