Midnight/Breakfast Run Update

On a chilly morning on October 14th, Holy Rosary Breakfast Run team went out very early, and, on behalf of the generosity of our Parish, brought delicious homemade food made by eight boys, warm clothing and much love and fellowship to approximately 40 homeless people in NYC.

Great team effort. Behind each Run doing prep work usually involves about thirty volunteers. We call this our Home Team. There are usually a dozen volunteers that we call Runners who actually go to NYC.

There was a blend of experienced and many new people both on the Home Prep Team and the Runner Team (included six HS seniors from the WestLake Service Club! We love to have a mix of experienced and new people on a Run!

Holy Rosary has increased the amount of Runs we do and we were recently awarded a generous grant from Catholic Charities (the only Parish in the Archdiocese to receive the grant for our work with the Midnight Run). As a result, we need more volunteer help, especially in key leadership positions. 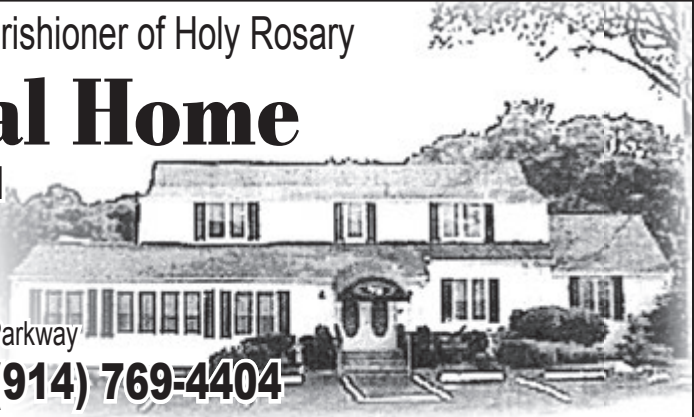
