**Did you know . . .** The basic rule for the disposition of blessed religious objects is to burn or to bury them. Here are a few examples: Palms are to be burned, and the ashes then used for distribution on Ash Wednesday or returned to the ground. Excess holy water must be poured into the ground. In all, the underlying idea is that what has been dedicated to God should be returned to God. Never should one just "throw out" what has been dedicated to God.

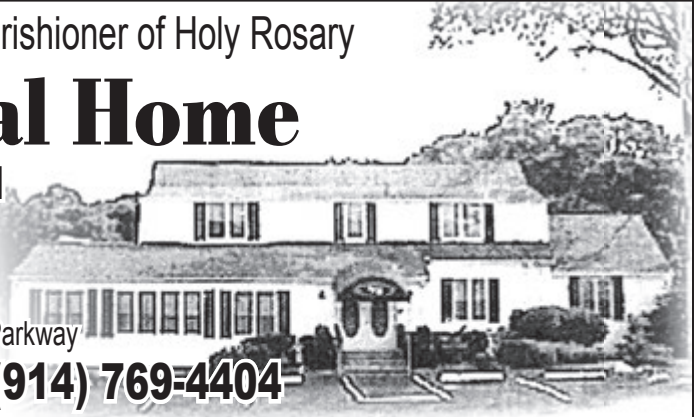
