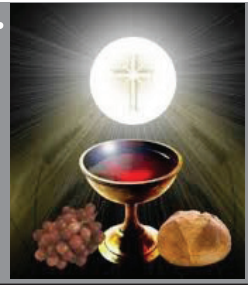

THE BODY OF CHRIST

The Universal Church celebrates God's most holy gift to us - the Body of Christ.

STATISTICS ON PRIESTS

Parishes will continue to merge based on the forecast of fewer priests. In 1970, 571 parishes were without a resident pastor. That number has grown nationwide to 3,363. In the 1970s our archdiocese had 1,352 priests. In 2016 we had 570. The number of priests across the US was 60,000 in 1970. In 2016 it was 37,192. These stats come from the Center for Applied Research at Georgetown. By combining parishes the church can conserve resources. Our own parish goal is the maintain vibrancy and sustainability in addition to encouraging our young people to become priests and nuns.

RESPECT LIFE

Respect for Human Life from conception until natural death is something children must be taught, not mainly with words, but by the example of their parents. Parents are called to pass on to their children the awareness that life must always be defended. Parents have the responsibility to teach their children that human life from the womb is a gift from God.

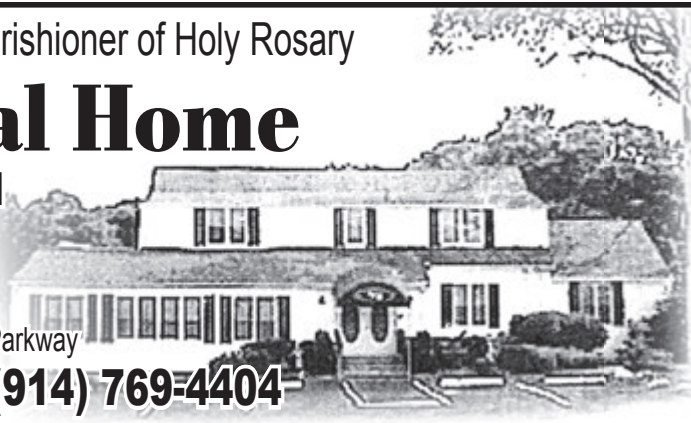
