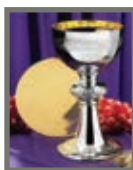

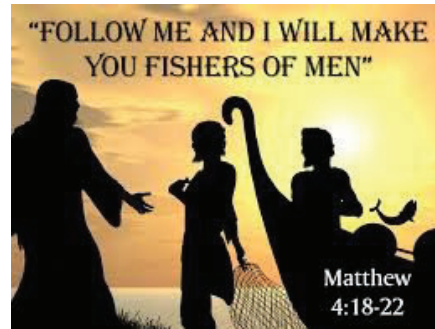

Today's readings point out how powerful the word of God can be to bring about change in the lives of those who hear it—even when it comes from such an unwilling prophet as Jonah. (Read the whole book of Jonah for a wonderful and surprising humorous tale of God's most stubborn prophet.) God's world can even change the heart of a city as it does the citizens of Nineveh, who turn from their evil ways at the preaching of Jonah. Or it can move the hearts of four fishermen who found themselves at the end of the day leaving behind the life they had led for many years to follow a stranger who had simply called out, "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." Paul writes that the world in its present form is passing away. It might not be doing so as quickly as we might sometimes wish but the life-giving, life-transforming power of God's word continues to bring the reign of God into our world in both subtle and surprising ways. What change of direction is God calling to in your life?

READINGS . . .

Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

1st Reading – Jonah 3:1-5, 10

The word of the LORD came to Jonah, saying: "Set out for the great city of Nineveh, and announce to it the message that I will tell you." So Jonah made ready and went to Nineveh, according to the LORD'S bidding. Now Nineveh was an enormously large city; it took three days to go through it. Jonah began his journey through the city, and had gone but a single day's walk announcing, "Forty days more and Nineveh shall be destroyed, " when the people of Nineveh believed God; they proclaimed a fast and all of them, great and small, put on sackcloth. ¹⁰ When God saw by their actions how they turned from their evil way, he repented of the evil that he had threatened to do to them; he did not carry it out.

Gospel – Mark 1:14-20

After John had been arrested, Jesus came to Galilee proclaiming the gospel of God: "This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel." As he passed by the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting their nets into the sea; they were fishermen. Jesus said to them, "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." Then they abandoned their nets and followed him. He walked along a little farther and saw James, the son of Zebedee and his brother John. They too were in a boat mending their nets. Then he called them. So they left their father Zebedee in the boat along with the hired men and followed him.

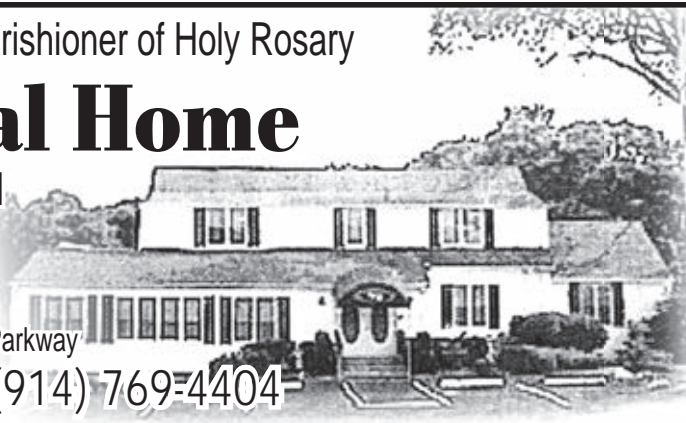

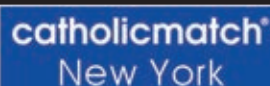
