TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round-trip coach class on Delta, United or other IATA member. Meals served in flight.

LAND TRANSPORTATION & SERVICES: By deluxe air-conditioned motor coach with professional driver, services of an English-speaking Tour Guide, all admission & entrance fees and transfers to and from international airports. Mass scheduled daily. Daily schedule as per your itinerary, however we reserve the right to modify or adjust any itinerary if circumstances deem necessary.

LODGING: First class accommodations based upon double occupancy with limited single accommodations available at an additional charge of \$600.

MEALS: Breakfast Buffet and Dinner DAILY.

ALSO INCLUDED IN PRICE: All taxes, including airport taxes. Gratuities for tour directors, local guides, bus drivers, porters, wait staff, housekeeping and front desk personnel. Tipping will be conducted by a tour leader during the course of your tour.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: The cost of obtaining your passport and visa fees to some countries, meals not included in the itinerary, wines, liquors, bottled waters, coffee or tea, personal items, laundry services, room service charges, long-distance phone calls, excess baggage, airport service charges and any sightseeing not included in the itinerary.

GROUP REQUIREMENT: The minimum number of passengers needed to assure a group's departure is 15. We reserve the right to cancel up to 30 days from departure should the total number of registered passengers be fewer than 15. If there are fewer than 15 passengers, Pilgrimage Tours will do all that is possible to assure your group's departure without having to resort to charging a supplemental fee for the group. If Pilgrimage Tours cancels, you will receive a full refund.

DEPOSIT AND FULL PAYMENT: A deposit/payment of \$500 towards the price of the tour, per person is required to book your reservation. The balance is to be paid in full two months prior to departure; September 3, 2019. Balances not paid by this date may be subject to a \$100 late payment fee. Reservations made within 45 days of departure may be subject to a \$100 late reservation fee. Upon receipt of your completed registration form and deposit, a confirmation invoice along with a travel insurance brochure will be mailed to you.

INSURANCE: Trip Cancellation and Interruption Insurance is highly recommended. Cancellation fees are covered by CSA Travel Protection's plan, as long as your premium has been paid, your policy is in effect and the reason for your canceling is insurable. Waivers for pre-existing medical conditions are available at no extra cost, but your policy must be purchased before your final payment for the tour.

CANCELLATION FEES: Passengers not taking the CSA travel insurance need to be aware of the following cancellation fees. From day of registration to 90 days prior to departure, there is a non-refundable administration fee of \$100. The remaining cancellation fee schedule is as follows: 89-60 days = \$300; 59-45 days = 50% of tour price; 44-31 days = 75% of tour price; 30-15 days = 80% of tour price; 14 days or less = 100% of tour price.

DAILY MASS AT THE HOLY SITES

A CATHOLIC PILGRIMAGE TOUR TO THE HOLY LAND

September 14, 2020 - Monday DETROIT / ISRAEL

Today we depart the United States on our flight to The Holy Land, arriving in Tel Aviv the following day. Meals are served on board our transatlantic flight.

September 15, 2020 - Tuesday TEL AVIV / HAIFA / MOUNT CARMEL / SEA OF GALILEE / TIBERIAS

This morning we arrive in Tel Aviv. We are met by our Pilgrimage Tours' tour escort and board our motor coach. We drive north along the sand dunes of the Mediterranean coast to visit Haifa, ascending the heights of Mount Carmel for one Israel's best views high above the Mediterranean, we see the place where the prophet Elijah was instrumental in the defeat of the prophets of Ba'al. Here we will visit the Stella Maris Monastery and celebrate Mass at the Shrine of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. We continue on to the Sea of Galilee. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

September 16, 2020 - Wednesday TIBERIAS / CANA / NAZARETH

Following breakfast, we drive to Cana for a renewal of wedding vows in the church where Jesus performed his first miracle, by turning water into wine at the Wedding Feast. Next we arrive in Nazareth where Jesus spent his childhood. Here we will visit and celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Annunciation, where the archangel Gabriel told Mary that she would "*bring forth a son*". We return to the Sea of Galilee for the afternoon at leisure at the beach. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

September 17, 2020 - Thursday TIBERIAS / MOUNT OF BEATITUDES / TABGHA / CAPERNAUM

Our day of sightseeing begins with a drive to the Mount of Beatitudes, where we retell the Sermon on the Mount while overlooking the Jordan Valley and the Sea of Galilee. Following Mass, we visit Tabgha and the Church of Heptapegon ("seven springs"). In the church's mosaic floor the multiplication of the loaves and fishes is commemorated. We visit the nearby Church of the Primacy of Peter on the shore of the Sea of Galilee where Peter received his commission from Jesus to "*feed my sheep*". Next we enjoy our "St. Peter's lunch" on the Sea of Galilee. In the afternoon, we arrive in the town where Jesus' ministry was centered, Capernaum, where we see the remains of an early Church, the ruins of Peter's House, and the ancient synagogue where Jesus preached. Our day concludes with a classic boat ride across the tranquil waters of the Sea of Galilee recalling the miracle of walking on water and calling on Peter and Andrew to become "fishers of men". Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

September 18, 2020 - Friday MOUNT TABOR / JORDAN RIVER / JERUSALEM

Today we leave Galilee for our journey to Judea through Samaria. En route we ascend Mount Tabor; the Mount of Transfiguration. We visit and celebrate Mass at the place of the transfiguration in one of the most beautiful churches in the Holy Land at the summit of the dome like mountain. Next we descend to the Jordan River to Yardenit, where Jesus was immersed in the waters by John the Baptist. Here we renew our own baptismal promises in the cleansing waters. We travel south to Jerusalem and arrive for dinner and overnight.

September 19, 2020 - Saturday JERUSALEM / BETHLEHEM / MOUNT OF OLIVES

Our day begins with a short drive to Shepherds Field with its caves that were typical of the stables of Jesus' time. It is here where the angel appeared to the shepherds and led them to Bethlehem. Here we pause for our own celebration of Mass. Following Mass, we make the short drive to Bethlehem, the birthplace of Jesus, and visit Manger Square and the Church of the Nativity. Here we will see the Grotto of the Holy Family and the Cave of St. Jerome. We also visit the adjacent St. Catherine's Church. While in Bethlehem, we

enjoy time for shopping one of the local merchants, offering olive wood carvings, crafts and other artwork. In the afternoon, we return to Jerusalem and arrive at the Mount of Olives, with its dramatic view of the walled Old City of Jerusalem. This is followed by a visit to the Church of Pater Noster where Jesus taught the "Our Father", and the Chapel of the Ascension. Finally, we visit the Church of All Nations and the Garden of Gethsemane. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

September 20, 2020 - Sunday JERUSALEM / MOUNT ZION

Early this morning we visit St. Anne's Church as well as the adjacent, open air Pool of Bethesda where Jesus performed a miracle cure and the infirm have sought healing for centuries. Next we recall the final hours of Jesus' life at Pilate's Judgment Hall, the Chapel of Flagellation and the Arch of the Ecce Homo "*Behold, the man*", the Lithostrotos where we see the ancient carvings in the stone floor of the basement. From here we will walk and pray along the Via Dolorosa – the "Stations of the Cross" where Jesus carried and fell beneath the weight of his cross to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. We'll celebrate Mass in this most holy of places followed by some time to explore this place of Jesus' tomb. From here we walk the "Cardo", the ancient Roman road towards the Western Wall of the Temple or "Wailing Wall", currently Judaism's holiest site where people from around the world come to pray. From here we arrive at The Upper Room, (Room of the Last Supper and Pentecost) a place of prayer, song and praise. We also visit King David's tomb, just below the Upper Room. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.


SEPTEMBER 21, 2020 - MONDAY BETHANY / MASADA / THE DEAD SEA

Following breakfast, our day begins with a visit to Bethany to see the home of Mary and Martha and the Tomb of Lazarus where Jesus "*cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth*" and Lazarus was risen from the dead. Following Mass at the Church of Saint Lazarus, we proceed to Masada, where we ascend by cable car on a spectacular ride to the top of the fortress palace of Herod, which was made famous by Jewish Zealots during the Roman siege from 70-73 AD. We see the remains of the fortifications, synagogue, storehouses, cisterns, and the 6th century Byzantine Church. Next, we enjoy some leisure time on the beach at the Dead Sea – the absolute lowest point on Earth where the salty

water is so buoyant that sinking is IMPOSSIBLE. We return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

September 22 & 23, 2020 - Tuesday & Wednesday JERUSALEM / EMMAUS / EIN KAREM / TEL AVIV / DETROIT

This morning we drive to the traditional location of Emmaus, in the town of Abu Ghosh where we visit its beautiful Notre Dame Church. We continue on to Ein Karem for a visit to the birthplace of John the Baptist, as well as the Church of the Visitation, where we celebrate Mass. It is here where the Blessed Virgin Mary proclaimed her famous hymn of thanksgiving known as the Magnificat. As we return to Jerusalem, we visit the moving Yad V'shem Museum, Israel's "national holocaust museum". In the early afternoon we return to our hotel in Jerusalem to relax before this evening's "Farewell Dinner" at a local restaurant. Following dinner, we proceed to Tel Aviv's Ben Gurion Airport for our late night return flight home, arriving in the United States early the following morning. Though we come to the end of our time of pilgrimage, our faith is deepened and our hearts stirred. Reading our Bible and seeking Christ as pilgrims in this life will forever take on new meaning for every one of us.
