### **Description of Community Events:**

**St. Pio Parish Family Festival:** Help in the Kid's Games under Adult Supervisor.

**Trunk or Treat:** Help plan, organize and act in the Haunted House portion of the Trunk or Treat. This event will require some meeting time before the actual event to plan, set-up and decorate. Always a Teen favorite!

**Bingo at American House:** Help the Residents at American House play Bingo. Students will rotate jobs as bingo callers, sorters or helpers. All prizes are donated and it's free for the Residents. Permission slip required.

**Christmas Cookie Baking Event:** Come and help us make Christmas Cookies. Parent Volunteers will bring their recipes & ingredients and help students in preparing & baking the cookies for the Residents at American House.

**Souper Bowl of Caring:** Students promote awareness for the poor and hungry by putting on skits and collecting with soup pots after Mass. This event does require one meeting time to prepare skit and with enough volunteers you will be responsible for only one Mass this weekend.

**Living Stations of the Cross:** Students will act out the Stations of the Cross for a presentation on Good Friday. Participation in this event counts as 2 projects due to its length. Students will meet once per week during Lent to practice. This is a great way to do something meaningful for Lent!

**Easter Egg Hunt:** Students help organize and run the Easter Egg Hunt. One meeting time to prepare and help fill eggs will be required.

**Earth Day Planting & Clean-Up:** To help Care for God's Creation, one of the Catholic Social Teachings, Students will help clean-up and plant in St. Pio grounds and/or Cemetery Areas.

**Vacation Bible School:** Sign up to be a Youth Leader for the entire week of VBS.
