

2019 Catholic School Sweepstakes **-sponsored by Catholic Life Insurance-**

The Catholic Life Sweepstakes is one of SJPICHS's major fund raisers. This year, as stipulated in the student-parent handbook, each family is required to sell 40 raffle tickets or make a \$200 donation.

100% of the money raised goes directly to our school and helps keep our tuition low!

Goals:

- Raise awareness of our school in the local community
- ***Every family*** to sell 40 tickets; incentives are for individual sales; families with multiple students will share incentives, unless each student in the family sells above the required \$200 per family
- Financial goal is \$38,000 and 100% participation

Student Selling Procedure:

1. The ticket price is \$5 per ticket.
2. **IN ORDER TO BE AN ELIGIBLE ENTRY, THE TICKET STUB MUST BE FULLY COMPLETE, INCLUDING THE STUDENT'S NAME. PLEASE VERIFY THAT EACH TICKET IS COMPLETE BEFORE YOU TURN THEM IN OR THEY WILL BE DISQUALIFIED!**
3. Student keeps the ticket stub with purchaser information noted. Purchaser keeps the advertisement portion, however does not need it to claim the prize.
4. Enclosed is a sample sales letter for students to make their own & send to family & friends.

(Note: Checks made payable to SJPII)

Student Return Procedure:

1. The student has been provided with a white envelope to turn in sold tickets and money.
2. The student will place sold tickets, verified cash and checks in the envelope provided and seal the envelope with the parent at home. Complete the envelope with the number of tickets sold and the money being turned in.
3. The student should turn in tickets and money to their solidarity leader on the **Tuesday turn-in date listed on the back of this document.**
4. If a student sells all original tickets and would like more, please fill out the request form enclosed and return to the front office.
5. **All tickets sold or unsold must be returned by 7 January 2020.**
6. For families selling less than \$200, the family account will be billed the difference between the amount sold and the \$200 requirement by the middle of February 2020.

Opt-Out Procedure:

If the family wishes to donate the \$200 instead of selling tickets, please do the following:

1. Write a check or enclose cash for \$200; return all unused tickets; indicate on the envelope the choice to donate by checking the appropriate box. There are a limited number of tickets. Returning the tickets allows the school the opportunity to sell them.
2. The school will provide you with a letter indicating the donation for tax purposes.

Student Incentives

We are simplifying the incentives and sales again this year.

Five turn-in dates:

Tuesday, 10 December	Goal: 10 tickets
Tuesday, 7 January	Goal: 10 tickets

The following incentives will be given per 5 tickets:

5 tickets – big cookie at lunch
10 tickets – Blue & Gold pass
15 tickets – big cookie at lunch
20 tickets – Blue & Gold pass
25 tickets – Free dress pass
30 tickets – Free dress pass
35 tickets – Free dress pass
40 tickets – Free dress pass

Incentives will be distributed on Thursdays following the turn-in dates:

Thursday, 9 January

Sell all tickets, or take the Opt-Out, by 10 December, and receive all incentives above, PLUS four additional Blue & Gold passes:

Two passes for Monday, 16 December & Tuesday, 17 December
(the two days before final exams)

AND

Two additional passes for use in the second semester

ADDITIONAL PRIZES

- **Top Selling Solidarity:** receives a pizza & soda float party sponsored by Catholic Life Insurance
- **Top Seller:** \$50 Visa gift card
- **2nd & 3rd Runner-Up Sellers:** \$25 Visa gift card each
- Families who sell all tickets or choose opt-out option by 10 December are eligible for a drawing of \$50 off 20-21 registration or if a senior then \$50 family account (one winner per class); drawing to be held in January 2020
- Students who turn-in at least 20 sold tickets or choose opt-out option will be eligible for a monthly drawing for \$10 gift cards to local eateries; eligible for each drawing until your name is drawn or we run out of gift cards!
