Super Cash Bonanza

The Knights of Columbus 2018 Super Cash Bonanza has started. This is the major fundraiser for charities. If you'd like to purchase tickets to support this fundraiser, please contact Tony Hamric at 740-412-0919 or trhamric@aol.com. Tickets are \$5.00, & must be turned in no later than April 23, 2018. Drawing will be May 19, 2018, and winners aren't required to be present.

1st prize is \$49,680 (\$414/month for 10 years)

K of C Measure Up Campaign

The local Measure Up campaign collection will take place on May 4th and 5th at Wal-Mart and Rural King. The "flagship" charity of the Ohio Knights of Columbus has long been **Support for Citizens with Developmental Disabilities**. In recent years, the Knights of Columbus have been recognized as a major corporate sponsor to the International Special Olympics with many local councils, including many in Ohio, that sponsor local events.

The primary fundraiser assisting those with developmental disabilities is the annual **Measure Up Campaign**. This fundraising effort raises approximately \$370,000 for over 322 statewide and local caring agencies that sponsor a variety of training and support programs. Of the money collected, 80% is returned to the local councils for donating to their local agencies. The remaining 20% is used for statewide programs.

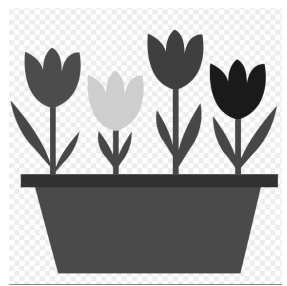
Confirmation Preparations BEGIN
