**CEMETERY NEWS:** Dear Parishioners: The Cemetery Board would like to inform you that in the very near future, we have a contractor in the cemetery to removing some badly damaged trees. During this time, portions of the cemetery may be closed for a short period. The trees in question include two large maples in the St. Matthew Section. While the remaining trees are around the rental house, posing a danger both to headstones and the home.

Over the last few years, we have been adding new trees to the cemetery including Redbuds and Yoshino Cherries in the middle section along with Norway Spruce and various maples, beeches and oaks. This past summer we planted a Honey Locust in the front by the house in honor of the Columbus Diocese 150th anniversary. We anticipate planting another to match it on the south side of the house and then a couple of new maples.

While we hate to lose trees of this size, they do pose safety issues to both property and people.

We appreciate your cooperation and understanding during this time.
