

A Glance at Blended Learning for Grade 3 to Grade 8

Grades 3 & 4:

Students are engaged in reading nonfiction texts, novels that support the units of study from the Archdiocesan Curriculum and accountable discussions. Math manipulatives are used to learn new concepts and to solve word problems. Analysis and critical thinking is evident across all curriculum areas.

Grades 5 - 8

Students are involved in independent and group projects that emphasize choice and responsibility. Research, expository and argumentative writing are conducted and shared throughout the year. Field trips correlate with the classroom curriculum. Class discussion are conducted to foster deeper thinking and to create cooperative learning.
