**Collection Protocol:** Starting this January St. Joseph's parish in Killdeer will be updating their collection protocol. After the collection during Mass, the ushers will no longer bring the money to the front. Instead two unrelated adult ushers will place the money into a tamper proof sealed bag, date it, and sign it. Then, they will place the sealed bag in the safe found in the confessional. After both weekend Masses, the sealed bags will be opened in the presence of two unrelated adults and counted at a basement table or if needed in the office area. After counting, the counted money will be again put in a sealed bag with deposit slip and dropped off in the drop box at the bank.
