Statues Getting Painted at St. Joseph's Killdeer: This week the statue of St. Joseph and the statue of our Blessed Mother in the grotto area where the confessional used to be will be sent off to Nardane Inc. in Reynolds, ND to get repainted. It is the same artist who painted the two statues in the sanctuary of Mary's Assumption and the Sacred Heart. After being repainted these statues will all match in color and style. When they return early next year we will have them installed where they originally were, that is, where the banners are presently hanging. There are niches there behind the wood coverings and banners. This will allow everyone during Mass to be able to look at these statues while in prayer. You may be wondering what we will be doing with the grotto area. During the Christmas season Jesus' nativity scene will be there. Afterwards we may place the Divine Mercy image there or an image of the Holy Family. If you have any ideas talk to Fr. Joseph, Dcn. Dan or Nancy Tuhy, or anyone on the parish council.

Year of St. Joseph: Pope Francis on December 8 announced a year of St. Joseph. Remember a few years back there was the Year of Mercy? This is similar. There will be special graces that come during this year for anyone desiring them and special indulgences are granted by the Holy Father during this time. This year began December 8 of this year and goes till December 8 of 2021. December 8, 2020 marks the 150 anniversary of when Pope Pius IX proclaimed St. Joseph patron of the Universal Church. Moreover, this year is very special for Killdeer and Twin Buttes parishes who are named after this great saint. May St. Joseph, patron of the Universal Church protect us from harm and keep us safe when we breathe our last. May we all have a holy death as he did. In Killdeer, the stained glass window on the bottom of the front left side will depict St. Joseph's holy death. And the window on the top front right side will depict St. Joseph King and Protector of the Church. In Twin Buttes, the stained glass window of St. Joseph holding the child Jesus will be placed on the front left side when the church renovation is complete.


