There are two days in the season of Lent where Christians step away from their Lenten observances so as to celebrate God's good work in humanity. The first is the Solemnity of St. Joseph which falls on March 19 and the second is the Annunciation to Mary that she will bear Jesus, a date we can all easily figure out.

These feasts are so big that even if they fall on a Friday we are able to eat meat on that day. This year the feast of St. Joseph does just that. It is Friday March 19th. This is a special day for two of the parishes that I pastor both with St. Joseph's namesake. At St. Joseph's in Killdeer that evening we will have Mass at 6:00 p.m. followed by a nice roast beef dinner. At St. Joseph's in Twin Buttes we will have Mass at 6:00 p.m. Central Time the day before on the Vigil and depending upon where construction is on the church at the time we may have a meal following Holy Mass.

This is a day the whole Church celebrates with great love for and honor to the foster father of our Lord Jesus Christ. God has done something great in this poor carpenter which God wants to share with all of us.

This day of traditional celebration came about more than 1200 years ago in Italy. At that time through his intercession St. Joseph stopped a major drought that was impacting the country. Since then St. Joseph is known for stopping drought and for protecting all Christians. He is named patron of the Universal Church and also called Terror of Demons, meaning, he's a pretty awesome guy!

Be sure to put March 19th on the calendar of your mind so when the day arrives you know to rejoice in the Lord that day. Pray to St. Joseph also for a holy death. May we all join him in heaven.

Therefore, Catholics are not obligated to maintain the usual Lenten abstinence or fast this Friday, March 19. Our celebration meal menu will include roast beef with a variety of salads and desserts. There will be a free will offering with proceeds to go to the Dunn County Food Pantry.
