***Who made us?**

God made us.

***Who is God?**

***Why did God make us?**

***From whom do we learn to know, love and serve God?**

We find the chief truths taught by Jesus Christ through the Catholic Church in the Apostles' Creed. It is called the Apostles Creed because in it are all the most important truths Christ taught to His Apostles.
