

From the Pastor: Basic Questions and Answers about the Catholic Faith

Here is a continuation of the most basic beliefs of our Christian Faith. Some of these questions and answers are verbatim from the Baltimore Catechism and others are compiled from Sacred Scripture and Tradition. Many of these will require memorization for those making their first Holy Communion and receiving Confirmation. All adults of course should have these answers memorized too.

***What is sin?**

Sin is an offence against God and one another. We sin when we know what is right but then choose to do the wrong thing.

How do we get rid of our sins?

Our sins are removed by asking God for forgiveness for them, by making amends for the bad we have done to God or to others, and by receiving the sacraments often especially the Sacrament of Confession and worthily receiving Holy Communion.

How do we ask God to forgive us?

Praying to God an Act of Contrition whole heartedly opens our hearts to God's forgiveness.

***How do we pray an Act of Contrition?**

O My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against You whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with Your help to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In his name, my God, have mercy. Amen

****Who started the Church?**

Jesus Christ started the Church.

****What kind of Church did Jesus establish?**

He established one Church, a holy Church, a catholic or universal Church, and an apostolic Church. Therefore, we Christians believe in one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church.

Pastors may shorten the time of preparation in cases of convalidation. It is highly recommended that the couple finish all elements of marriage preparation at least six weeks prior to the wedding. (*Paragraph 146, Chapter 3, Second Synod of Bismarck Diocese 2016*)
