ADVENT 2016

Advent is the beginning of a new liturgical year for the Roman Catholic Church and a period of preparation, extending over four Sundays, before Christmas.

Sometimes people make the mistake of thinking that Advent is part of the Christmas celebrations. In fact, Advent is a separate time of preparation all of its own. For the Catholic Church Christmas doesn't begin until the first Mass is celebrated on Christmas Eve and continues until the Epiphany, which occurs on January 8, 2017.
