PLANNED GIVING: Capital Campaign...

The Diocesan-wide *It's our Church, It's Our Future* Capital Campaign will soon be upon us. (A) The plot owner is responsible for the upkeep of potted or planted flowers.
(B) Shrubs, bushes and trees are NOT allowed.
(C) Artificial or plastic flowers/arrangements are not permitted. This is due to safety reasons.

Flags: Small flags are permitted on graves, but they must be maintained and removed when they become damaged.
